Rebekah Esau Elected as KSU ACJA Chapter Vice President

Rebekah Esau, junior in criminology/sociology at K-State, was elected to serve as chapter vice president for the spring of 2016 on October 28, 2015. She will remain as Vice President – Elect until such time and will receive guidance and advice before assuming her role officially on Friday, December 11, 2015.

Previously, Ms. Esau served as chapter president and vice president of Zeta Rho Omega, a subordinate chapter of ACJA-LAE located at Johnson County Community College. "I was approached by Adriana (current chapter president) and asked me if I would consider serving as vice president of KSU ACJA in the spring; I told her I would think about it but in the end I decided to proceed as I felt that the chapter needs an experienced leader and I believe I can help us move forward upon Adriana graduating this December." The members of KSU ACJA agreed with the nomination and Ms. Esau was elected by unanimous consent.

"My goals for the spring would be to assist the president in any reforms he may see that are needed to further the mission of KSU ACJA, and also in preparing the members for the National Conference that is taking place in Sacramento, California in March. I also want to help in boosting our recruitment efforts by letting other students know of the benefits that comes with joining our association." said Ms. Esau.

Upon Ms. Olivas graduating, Cody Blake, the current chapter vice president, will assume the president's role and Ms. Esau will begin her duties at that time also.
