

## **Alvin and RosaLee Sarachek Merit Scholarship in Basic or Applied Biosciences for Community College Graduates**

Kansas State University is proud to announce a \$10,000 renewable scholarship for transfer students for a total of \$20,000.

To qualify for consideration, students must:

- ▶ have 3.75 cumulative GPA from a Kansas community college
- ▶ plan to pursue a degree full-time in one of the Kansas State University bio-sciences programs on the Manhattan campus (See website for complete list.)
- ▶ be a legal resident of Kansas with or acquiring an Associate Degree from a Kansas public community college

To be considered students must:

- Be admitted to K-State by completing the combined K-State admissions and scholarship application by February 1

- Submit all recent official transcripts.
- Complete the supplemental application and submit all required supporting materials by February 15

Finalists will be contacted for an on-campus interview to be scheduled for March 2012. The award is made for the following fall term.

Terms of renewal:

The second year renewal is contingent on the completion of 30 credit hours at K-State with a cumulative GPA of 3.5 or higher.
