About qualified admissions

Qualified admissions are a set of standards used by the six state universities in Kansas to review applicants for undergraduate admission. These standards are set by the Kansas Board of Regents, the governing body for Kansas universities. These standards have been in place since 2015.

Requirements

• Students from Kansas high schools must complete the precollege or Kansas Scholars curriculum with at least a 2.0 GPA. Students from other states must complete the precollege curriculum with at least a 2.5 GPA.

(AND)

- Achieve one of the following:
 - ACT score of 21 or higher; OR
 - SAT ERW+M score of 1060 or higher; Of
 - Graduate in the top one-third of their class

AND

• If applicable, achieve a 2.0 GPA or higher on any college credit taken in high school.

Appeals

Students who do not meet these standards will be considered for admission on a case-by-case basis. Some students may be asked to send additional information and documentation.

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
