Minutes  
College of Arts and Sciences Faculty Meeting  
April 1, 2004

Dean Steve White convened the meeting shortly after 4:00.

Prof. Peter Sherwood moved approval of the minutes for the Feb. 12, 2004 minutes; Prof. Dave Rintoul seconded. Approval was unanimous.

Dean White announced that with ongoing reorganization in the Deans' Office, Dean Larry Rodgers will be assuming duties as the new Course and Curriculum Czar. Susan Gormley suggested the terms should be King, instead.

Prof. Chuck Moore, Course and Curriculum Committee Chair, announced minor, typographical changes to the green sheet agenda. Dean Alison Wheatley moved approval of course and curriculum changes; Prof. John Harrington seconded. Approval was unanimous.

Dean Rodgers conducted the elections for two open positions on the College Course and Curriculum Committee. The committee presented one candidate for each position: Yasmin Patell for the Sciences position and John Fliter for the Social Sciences position. Dean Rodgers asked if there were any nominations from the floor. There being none, both nominees were elected by acclamation.

Dean Rodgers announced the committee membership: Chuck Moore, Don Hedrick, John Fliter, Yasmin Patell, Lou Williams, Amitaba Chakrabarti, Lisa Harrington.

Prof. Rintoul suggested that the committee membership should be easily accessible from the College website. Dean Rodgers said the College will be redesigning the website and will include such information as past teaching award winners. Dean White thanked the recording, and departing, secretary.

Prof. Rintoul moved adjournment. Dean Wheatley seconded. Approval was unanimous.
