Minutes
College of Arts and Sciences Faculty Meeting
November 4, 2004

Dean White called the meeting to order at 4:02 pm.

The minutes of the October 7, 2004 meeting were approved as distributed.

Assoc. Dean Larry Rodgers, as a representative of the Course and Curriculum committee, presented the green sheet Course and Curriculum document. He announced that the course French Novel 718 had inadvertently been omitted from the green sheets. He also noted that in the green sheets addendum, the course Philosophy 360 should have read 365. Dean Rodgers moved that the green sheets be approved. The motion was seconded. During the discussion, John Harrington voiced some objection to the course being proposed by the Department of History, namely History 331. He moved that this course be excluded and sent back to the Course and Curriculum committee for further communication. Mainly this communication should include History, Sociology, Anthropology and Social Work, Geography and International Studies. Motion was seconded by Alison Wheatley and passed. This course will be sent back to the Course and Curriculum committee. Larry Rodgers then moved that the remainder of the Course and Curriculum changes be approved. Motion was seconded and passed.

Dean White announced that the Diversity Committee has been named and will soon be announced.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned.
