| Purpose | To promote and strengthen government service leadership. |
| Award | |
| <i>Tenable</i> | Current program of study. Graduating seniors can apply award to graduate school. |
| <i>Number & Amount</i> | Approximately 20 awards annually. Up to \$2000 but awards of \$1000 to \$1400 have been more common for recent Kansas State winners. |
| <i>Duration</i> | Applied to tuition bill. |
| Eligibility | |
| <i>Who</i> | Enrolled undergraduate or graduate student seeking career in government service. Major should fit with those aspirations. |
| <i>When</i> | Theoretically, freshman through final year in graduate school. However, few applicants will evince credible resumes before the sophomore year. |
| <i>Selection Criteria</i> | Commitment to a government service career demonstrated through resume and curriculum. Previous or planned participation in a public service internship. Application form is brief so transcript and references are probably scrutinized. |
| Campus Deadline | None. |
| Deadline | April 1 st in recent years. |
| Application | Application form. Transcripts. Resume that indicates relevant academic and campus/community accomplishments. Two letters of reference: one academic and one attesting to your interest in government service. |
