

## Phi Kappa Phi Study Abroad Grant

---

<b>Purpose</b>	From the website: <i>To help support undergraduates as they seek knowledge and experience in their academic fields by studying abroad.</i> One of several Phi Kappa Phi scholarship initiatives.
<b>Award</b>	
<i>Tenable</i>	Funds study abroad in any country. Supports programs during the summer, fall and/or spring semester after the February deadline.
<i>Number &amp; Amount</i>	45 grants per year. \$1000 each.
<i>Duration</i>	Single payment.
<b>Eligibility</b>	
<i>Who</i>	PKP membership <b>not</b> required. No lower than 3.5 GPA. All majors are eligible. At least two semesters remaining at K-State after you study abroad.
<i>When</i>	Applicants must have completed between 30 and 90 credits at the time of application (in February).
<i>Selection Criteria</i>	Good fit between goals and planned program abroad. Strong academic record. Past winners from Kansas State have been quite diverse in their interests.
<b>Campus Deadline</b>	None.
<b>Deadline</b>	February in recent years. The application does require confirmation of acceptance by your program. However, the Study Abroad Office can, in some instances, document <i>anticipated</i> program acceptance if the program deadline follows the award deadline.
<b>Application</b>	Application form. Essay that tells how your study abroad program relates to your future goals. Two letters of reference. Transcripts. Letter that confirms study abroad placement. Multiple copies required.
