Associate of Applied Science – Proposed Student Learning Outcomes**

Upon graduation, students receiving the Associate of Applied Science will be able to:

1. Demonstrate competency in the technical field completed at the Salina Area Technical School.
2. Demonstrate the ability to communicate clearly and concisely in written and oral communications.
3. Develop and demonstrate skills in gathering, sorting, analyzing, and presenting data relevant to the field of study.
4. Demonstrate a fundamental utilization of computer technology.
5. Exhibit a broad understanding of human behavior, globalization, cultural diversity, and ethical awareness.

****Notes:** The competencies above will be met to the level appropriate for an associate degree. This degree is the result of a partnership between Salina Area Technical School (SATS) and the College of Technology and Aviation. There are 62 – 65 hours required for graduation for this degree. Of the required hours, 33 to 45 are obtained by successfully completing one of eight technical certificates awarded by the Salina Area Technical School (SATS). The remaining hours in general studies (English, math, social science, etc.) are completed at the College of Technology and Aviation.
