

KONZA PRAIRIE BIOLOGICAL STATION SCHEDULE OF FEES

Konza Prairie Biological Station is managed by the Division of Biology, Kansas State University. The preserve lands are privately owned by The Nature Conservancy and the K-State Foundation. Operation and maintenance of the station is supported primarily by user fees, with additional financial support from Kansas State University, and the Kansas Agricultural Experiment Station.
