This checklist includes 440 species documented to have occurred in Kansas as of March 23, 1996. Of these thirteen have not been substantiated with physical evidence and are therefore designated as "hypothetical" and listed in square brackets ([]). Four additional species known from the state in historic times have been excluded because they no longer occur: the Passenger Pigeon and Carolina Parakeet, both now extinct, and the Sage Grouse and Black-capped Vireo, which have been extirpated from the state.
