The Bureau of Disease Control & Prevention requires the following immunizations for entry to child care facilities, family day care homes and preschools.

12 months (12-15 months)	MMR + PCV + Hib + Varicella + HepA DTaP(6 months after 3 <sup>rd</sup> Dose)
18 months	HepA (6 months after dose 1)
5 years	DTaP + MMR + IPV + Varicella

If your child does not have the required immunizations by their start date, licensing requires either an appointment card stating your child has an appointment to get immunizations, or a signed letter from a doctor stating that your child is behind on their immunizations and when they will be caught up on their immunizations.
