

# ***SPSS® for Windows® Installation Instructions (Site License)***

The following instructions are for installing SPSS using a site license. This document is for end users who are installing SPSS on their desktop computers. If you are a site administrator, see *Site License Administrators Guide.pdf* in the *Installation Documents* directory on the product CD-ROM for information about distributing the installation to end users.

During installation, you will be prompted for the following information. Except for the serial number, all information is required. Contact your site administrator if you do not have the required information.

## ***System Requirements for SPSS***

The minimum hardware and software requirements for SPSS are as follows:

### **Operating System**

- Microsoft® Windows XP (32-bit version) or Vista (32-bit and 64-bit versions).

### **Configuration**

- Intel or AMD x86 processor running at 1 gigahertz (GHz) or higher.
- 512 megabytes (MB) of RAM or more. At least 1 gigabyte (GB) is recommended.
- 450 MB of available hard-disk space.
- CD-ROM drive.
- Super VGA (800x600) or a higher-resolution monitor.
- For connecting with an SPSS Server, a network adapter running the TCP/IP network protocol.

### **Software**

- Internet Explorer 6.0

**Authorization Code**

You will also need your authorization code, which you should have received from your administrator. The authorization code enables you to obtain a license for Base and any SPSS add-on modules that you have purchased. If you cannot find your authorization code, contact your administrator. In some cases, you might have multiple codes. You will need all of them.

*Note:* You cannot run SPSS remotely via Windows Terminal Services or Citrix.

**Installing SPSS**

Your administrator might have given you a CD-ROM or identified a network location from which to install. Check with your administrator if you do not know how you are supposed to install SPSS.

*Note:* To install SPSS, you must be logged on to your computer with administrator privileges.

**Upgrading from a Previous Release**

You do not need to uninstall an old version of SPSS before installing the new version. If you want to keep both versions, be sure to install the new version in a separate directory. If you install the new version in the same directory in which a previous version is installed, the previous version is automatically uninstalled.

**Installing from a CD-ROM****Windows XP**

- ▶ Insert the CD-ROM into your CD-ROM drive. The AutoPlay feature presents a menu.
- ▶ On the AutoPlay menu, click Install SPSS, and then follow the instructions that appear on the screen. See [Notes for Installation](#) for any special instructions.

**Windows Vista**

You must run the AutoPlay as administrator:

- ▶ Close the AutoPlay window that automatically appeared.
- ▶ Using Windows Explorer, browse to the CD-ROM.
- ▶ Right-click *setup.exe* at the root of the CD and choose Run as Administrator.
- ▶ On the AutoPlay menu, click Install SPSS, and then follow the instructions that appear on the screen. See [Notes for Installation](#) for any special instructions.

**Installing from a Network Location**

- ▶ From the Windows Start menu, choose Run.

- ▶ In the Run dialog box, type the location that your administrator provided for the *setup.exe* file.
- ▶ On the AutoPlay menu, click Install SPSS, and then follow the instructions that appear on the screen. See [Notes for Installation](#) for any special instructions.

## **Notes for Installation**

This section contains special instructions for this installation.

**License type.** Be sure to select Site License.

**Serial number.** If SPSS Inc. provided a serial number, enter the one delivered with your product. Contact your administrator if you do not know the serial number.

## **Licensing Your Product**

After the main part of the installation is complete, click OK to launch the License Authorization Wizard. The License Authorization Wizard allows you to obtain a license for SPSS.

If you do not get a license now, you can enable a temporary trial license that allows SPSS to be used for a 14-day trial period. All add-on modules are enabled. After the trial period—which begins when the product is first used—SPSS will no longer run. Therefore, it is recommended that you obtain a license as soon as possible. You must either obtain a license or enable the temporary trial license to use SPSS.

*Note:* Licenses are tied to your computer's hardware with a **lock code**. If you replace your computer or its hardware, you will have a new lock code and will need to repeat the authorization process. If you find out that you exceeded the allowable number of authorizations specified in the license agreement, contact your administrator.

**Warning!** The license is sensitive to time changes. If you must change the system time and then cannot run the product, contact your administrator.

## **Using the License Authorization Wizard**

*Note:* If you are running Windows Vista, you may be prompted for administrator credentials. Without the correct credentials, you will not be able to run the License Authorization Wizard.

- ▶ If you don't launch the License Authorization Wizard during installation or cancel the License Authorization Wizard before obtaining a license, you can launch it by choosing License Authorization Wizard in the Windows Start menu program group for SPSS.
- ▶ When prompted, choose License my product now. If you want to enable the trial license instead, refer to [Enabling a Trial License](#) on p. 4.
- ▶ When prompted, enter one or more authorization codes. You should have received the authorization code(s) from your administrator.
- ▶ Choose an authorization method and complete the steps for each method.

**Internet.** If you have an Internet connection, this is the easiest method. The License Authorization Wizard automatically retrieves your license from SPSS Inc. After authorization, you do not need to be connected to the Internet to run SPSS. If your computer cannot access the Internet, this option is disabled. If your computer is behind a proxy, click Configure proxy settings and enter the appropriate settings. Contact your system administrator if you don't know these settings.

**E-mail.** Select your location to ensure the e-mail is routed correctly. Then choose whether you want to send the e-mail through your desktop e-mail program or through a Web-based e-mail application.

- If you choose the desktop option, a new message with the appropriate information will be created automatically.
- If you choose the Web-based option, you must first create a new message in your Web-based e-mail program. Then copy the message text from the License Authorization Wizard and paste it into your e-mail application.

Send the e-mail message and respond to the prompt in the License Authorization Wizard. Then click Done to close the License Authorization Wizard. When you receive your license code from an SPSS Customer Service representative, restart the License Authorization Wizard. On the Enter Codes panel, add the license code that you received and click Next to complete the process.

**Telephone.** When you select this method, the License Authorization Wizard displays your authorization code(s) and lock code. You will need these when you contact SPSS. Get an appropriate number from the Location and Phone Number list, and call SPSS. An SPSS Customer Service representative will then give you the license code, which you can enter in the next panel.

## ***Enabling a Trial License***

You can enable a trial license instead of installing the regular license. Refer to [Licensing Your Product](#) on p. 3 for information about how long the trial license lasts.

- ▶ Launch the License Authorization Wizard.
- ▶ When prompted, choose Enable a temporary trial period.
- ▶ When prompted, enter the trial license code in the Trial License box. Instead of typing or pasting the code, you can click the browse button to locate the trial license file in the product installation directory (typically *trial.txt*). The Trial License Wizard will read the license from the file and automatically fill in the box.

## ***Viewing Your License***

You can view the license by relaunching the License Authorization Wizard. The first panel displays the licensing information. Click Cancel when done, and click Yes when prompted about cancelling.

*Note:* You can also view the license by running the `SHOW LIC SPSS` syntax command.

## ***Installing Support for Dimensions Data Model and OLE DB Access***

To access OLE DB data sources, you must have the following installed on the same computer on which SPSS is installed:

- .NET Framework, version 2.0 or later
- Dimensions Data Model and OLE DB Access

These are available on the Autoplay menu. If you are not sure whether you have the .NET Framework, try installing the Dimensions Data Model first. The installation will check for the .NET Framework.

*Note:* All Dimensions products installed on one computer must be at the same version level. The version of the Dimensions Data Model on the CD-ROM is 4.5. If you have an older version of a Dimensions product installed, you will be prompted to uninstall it. Note that SPSS 15 or higher is compatible with the new version, but earlier versions of SPSS will not be able to use the latest Dimensions Data Model.

## ***Enabling Programmability***

You can enable programming SPSS with the following.

- **Python.** For more information about installation, refer to *SPSS-Python Integration Plug-in Installation Instructions.pdf* in the *Installation Documents* folder on the CD-ROM.

## ***Uninstalling SPSS***

To completely uninstall SPSS:

- ▶ Use the Windows Control Panel to remove SPSS.

## ***Updating, Modifying, and Renewing SPSS***

If you purchase additional add-on modules or renew your license, you will receive a new authorization code (or codes). For instructions on using the authorization code(s), see *Licensing Your Product* on p. 3 .
