Description of job responsibilities: The counseling or clinical psychology post-doctoral fellowship is a full-time 12-month temporary position. It is designed for advanced training and supervised practice to prepare an individual for a staff psychologist position in a university counseling service. Duties include 2000 hours of supervised practice professional psychology activity within the counseling service and also with special assignment to athletic department including athlete referrals, biofeedback, team and individual consults, performance enhancement class, psychological support for injury rehabilitation.

Qualifications: Necessary requirement completion of a pre-doctoral psychology internship from an APA accredited program. A doctoral degree in clinical or counseling psychology preferred. Preference given for experience within a college or university counseling service and evidence of special competence in sport psychology, performance enhancement, biofeedback training.
