 Plan with VP Shubert for physical plant upgrades—ongoing. Master Plan task force








Provost Office Realignment

- Need to reduce number of direct reports to allow focus on strategic rather than daily operations







- Creation of position of Vice Provost for Undergraduate Studies





Why a new position of Vice Provost for Undergraduate Studies?

- Undergraduate education is critical to the K-State vision, building on our already strong foundation
- Student Life—overall undergraduate student
 experience
- VP for UGS—undergraduate educational experience as envisioned in K-State 2025
- Focus areas: retention course management, academic advising, general education, interdisciplinary programs, UG research, service learning

- Need to assess where we are given questions raised in the search committee trainings
- Focus groups will be organized to find out what is working and what could be improved
