- Application fee.** (Domestic: \$40, Intl: \$55) Payable online with a credit card or with personal check (domestic applications only) or money order payable to the "KSU Graduate School." (PERSONAL CHECKS NOT ACCEPTED FOR INTL APPLICATIONS)
- Statement of objectives.** A succinct account of your academic aims and interests.
- Writing sample** of 8-15 pages of analytical or persuasive prose.
- Additional Creative Writing track writing sample:** Either 10-30 pages of prose or 6-10 poems.
- (2) official copies of your transcript** from each college or university you have attended. Official copies may be sent via postal mail or e-mail directly to the Department of English.
- (3) letters of recommendation** from persons qualified to speak informatively about your academic performance and potential for advanced study in English. Letters may be sent via email if sent directly from the authors.
- GRE scores.** The General test is required; the Subject test is not. Please arrange with ETS to have a copy of your score report sent to Kansas State University (Institution Code: R6334).
