New Course

College of Architecture, Planning & Design PhD Program

ADD: ENVD 899. Problems in Environmental Design & Planning (1-4) I, II, S. This course is intended to provide students an opportunity to focus on specific problems in environmental design and planning under the guidance of a member of the college's graduate faculty.
