**Request to adjust University Handbook B34: K-State Olathe**

**Rationale:**

K-State Olathe has opportunities to develop interdisciplinary faculty clusters in targeted research and scholarly areas linked to industry and technology in the Kansas City region. This language adds the ability for the School of Interdisciplinary and Applied Sciences to house its own interdisciplinary faculty and develop a tenure and promotion system that correlates with the transdisciplinary nature of their faculty activity.
