

**Minutes**  
**FSCOT meeting**  
**January 8, 2013, Union room 226, 3:30 pm**

Convened at 3:30 PM in Union 204

- 1) Approval of minutes from previous meeting (11/6/2012) – approved with minor revision, suggested by Brian Lindshield
- 2) Updates
  - a. Email taskforce – final submitted to Stafford outlining strengths and weaknesses of each proposed solution. The sticking point is the calendar, and how to make it useful for the “power-users” who depend on functionality currently found in Zimbra. It was noted that the state of Kansas is currently looking at Google solutions for other state agencies. Scheduling of resources (rooms) is very problematic in Google calendar. Hybrid options (one solution for students, another for faculty/staff) are still on the table.
  - b. Flexbook/e-textbook initiative – nothing substantive to date.
  - c. Survey replacement – Qualtrics, a comprehensive survey tool which is much more robust than the home-grown system, will hopefully be phased in. Funding solicited from colleges and departments. A demonstration of this tool should be scheduled for an upcoming FSCOT meeting.
  - d. iPad trainer for College of Ed (Denis Devaney) could also perhaps give a demo for FSCOT.
  - e. IT Security head (Robert Vaile) should come meet the committee and update us on the security scene.
- 3) New business for 2013
  - a. Salina wireless network access integration with KSU Wireless – solutions will be sought.
  - b. Eduroam ([http://www.eduroamus.org/eduroam\\_us\\_institutions](http://www.eduroamus.org/eduroam_us_institutions)) – Adoption by KSU necessitated new hardware (~\$100K), which has been ordered and installed within the next 2 months. Traveling KSU faculty and staff should soon be able to use this service at other cooperating institutions.
