TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. **Contract Documents:** In the event of a conflict in terms of language among the documents, the following order of precedence shall govern:
 - o Form DA 146a;
 - o written modifications to the executed contract;
 - o written contract signed by the parties;
 - o the RFP, including any and all amendments; and
 - o Contractor's written proposal submitted in response to the RFP as finalized.
2. **Contract Formation:** No contract shall be considered to have been entered into by the State until all statutorily required signatures and certifications have been rendered and a written contract has been signed by the successful contractor.
3. **Notices:** All notices, demands, requests, approvals, reports, instructions, consents or other communications (collectively "notices") that may be required or desired to be given by either party to the other shall be IN WRITING and addressed as follows:

or to any other persons or addresses as may be designated by notice from one party to the other.
4. **Termination for Cause:** The Director of Purchases may terminate this contract, or any part of this contract, for cause under any one of the following circumstances:
 - o the Contractor fails to make delivery of goods or services as specified in this contract;
 - o the Contractor provides substandard quality or workmanship;
 - o the Contractor fails to perform any of the provisions of this contract, or
 - o the Contractor fails to make progress as to endanger performance of this contract in accordance with its terms.The Director of Purchases shall provide Contractor with written notice of the conditions endangering performance. If the Contractor fails to remedy the conditions within ten (10) days from the receipt of the notice (or such longer period as State may authorize in writing), the Director of Purchases shall issue the Contractor an order to stop work immediately. Receipt of the notice shall be presumed to have occurred within three (3) days of the date of the notice.
5. **Termination for Convenience:** The Director of Purchases may terminate performance of work under this contract in whole or in part whenever, for any reason, the Director of Purchases shall determine that the termination is in the best interest of the State of Kansas. In the event that the Director of Purchases elects to terminate this contract pursuant to this provision, it shall provide the Contractor written notice at least 30 days prior to the termination date. The termination shall be effective as of the date specified in the notice. The Contractor shall continue to perform any part of the work that may have not been terminated by the notice.
6. **Rights and Remedies:** If this contract is terminated, the State, in addition to any other rights provided for in this contract, may require the Contractor to transfer title and deliver to the State in the manner and to the extent directed, any completed materials. The State shall be obligated only for those services and materials rendered and accepted prior to the date of termination.

In the event of termination, the Contractor shall receive payment prorated for that portion of the contract period services were provided to or goods were accepted by State subject to any offset by State for actual damages including loss of federal matching funds.

The rights and remedies of the State provided for in this contract shall not be exclusive and are in addition to any other rights and remedies provided by law.
7. **Force Majeure:** The Contractor shall not be held liable if the failure to perform under this contract arises out of causes beyond the control of the Contractor. Causes may include, but are not limited to, acts of nature, fires, tornadoes, quarantine, strikes other than by Contractor's employees, and freight embargoes.
8. **Waiver:** Waiver of any breach of any provision in this contract shall not be a waiver of any prior or subsequent breach. Any waiver shall be in writing and any forbearance or indulgence in any other form or manner by State shall not constitute a waiver.
9. **Independent Contractor:** Both parties, in the performance of this contract, shall be acting in their individual capacity and not as agents, employees, partners, joint ventures or associates of one another. The employees or agents of one party shall not be construed to be the employees or agents of the other party for any purpose whatsoever.

The Contractor accepts full responsibility for payment of unemployment insurance, workers compensation, social security, income tax deductions and any other taxes or payroll deductions required by law for its employees engaged in work authorized by this contract.
10. **Staff Qualifications:** The Contractor shall warrant that all persons assigned by it to the performance of this contract shall be employees of the Contractor (or specified Subcontractor) and shall be fully qualified to perform the work required. The Contractor shall include a similar provision in any contract with any Subcontractor selected to perform work under this contract.

Failure of the Contractor to provide qualified staffing at the level required by the contract specifications may result in termination of this contract or damages.
11. **Subcontractors:** The Contractor shall be the sole source of contact for the contract. The State will not subcontract any work under the contract to any other firm and will not deal with any subcontractors. The Contractor is totally responsible for all actions and work performed by its

subcontractors. All terms, conditions and requirements of the contract shall apply without qualification to any services performed or goods provided by any subcontractor.

12. **Proof of Insurance:** Upon request, the Contractor shall present an affidavit of Worker's Compensation, Public Liability, and Property Damage Insurance to the Division of Purchases.
13. **Conflict of Interest:** The Contractor shall not knowingly employ, during the period of this contract or any extensions to it, any professional personnel who are also in the employ of the State and providing services involving this contract or services similar in nature to the scope of this contract to the State. Furthermore, the Contractor shall not knowingly employ, during the period of this contract or any extensions to it, any state employee who has participated in the making of this contract until at least two years after his/her termination of employment with the State.
14. **Confidentiality:** The Contractor may have access to private or confidential data maintained by State to the extent necessary to carry out its responsibilities under this contract. Contractor must comply with all the requirements of the Kansas Open Records Act (K.S.A. 42-215 *et seq.*) in providing services under this contract. Contractor shall accept full responsibility for providing adequate supervision and training to its agents and employees to ensure compliance with the Act. No private or confidential data collected, maintained or used in the course of performance of this contract shall be disseminated by either party except as authorized by statute, either during the period of the contract or thereafter. Contractor agrees to return any or all data furnished by the State promptly at the request of State in whatever form it is maintained by Contractor. On the termination or expiration of this contract, Contractor will not use any of such data or any material derived from the data for any purpose and, where so instructed by State, will destroy or render it unreadable.
15. **Nondiscrimination and Workplace Safety:** The Contractor agrees to abide by all federal, state and local laws, and rules and regulations prohibiting discrimination in employment and controlling workplace safety. Any violations of applicable laws or rules or regulations may result in termination of this contract.
16. **Environmental Protection:** The Contractor shall abide by all federal, state and local laws, and rules and regulations regarding the protection of the environment. The Contractor shall report any violations to the applicable governmental agency. A violation of applicable laws or rule or regulations may result in termination of this contract for cause.
17. **Hold Harmless:** The Contractor shall indemnify the State against any and all loss or damage to the extent arising out of the Contractor's negligence in the performance of services under this contract and for infringement of any copyright or patent occurring in connection with or in any way incidental to or arising out of the occupancy, use, service, operations or performance of work under this contract.

The State shall not be precluded from receiving the benefits of any insurance the Contractor may carry which provides for indemnification for any loss or damage to property in the Contractor's custody and control, where such loss or destruction is to state property. The Contractor shall do nothing to prejudice the State's right to recover against third parties for any loss, destruction or damage to State property.

18. **Care of State Property:** The Contractor shall be responsible for the proper care and custody of any state owned personal tangible property and real property furnished for Contractor's use in connection with the performance of this contract. The Contractor shall reimburse State for such property's loss or damage caused by Contractor, normal wear and tear excepted.
19. **Prohibition of Gratuities:** Neither the Contractor nor any person, firm or corporation employed by the Contractor in the performance of this contract shall offer or give any gift, money or anything of value or any promise for future reward or compensation to any State employee at any time.
20. **Retention of Records:** Unless the State specifies in writing a different period of time, the Contractor agrees to preserve and make available at reasonable times all of its books, documents, papers, records and other evidence involving transactions related to this contract for a period of five (5) years from the date of the expiration or termination of this contract.

Matters involving litigation shall be kept for one (1) year following the termination of litigation, including all appeals, if the litigation exceeds five (5) years.

The Contractor agrees that authorized federal and state representatives, including but not limited to, personnel of the using agency; independent auditors acting on behalf of state and/or federal agencies shall have access to and the right to examine records during the contract period and during the five (5) year post contract period. Delivery of and access to the records shall be within five (5) business days at no cost to the state.

21. **Antitrust:** If the Contractor elects not to proceed with performance under any such contract with the State, the Contractor assigns to the State all rights to and interests in any cause of action it has or may acquire under the anti-trust laws of the United States and the State of Kansas relating to the particular products or services purchased or acquired by the State pursuant to this contract.
22. **Modification:** This contract shall be modified only by the written agreement and approval of the parties. No alteration or variation of the terms and conditions of the contract shall be valid unless made in writing and signed by the parties. Every amendment shall specify the date on which its provisions shall be effective.
23. **Assignment:** The Contractor shall not assign, convey, encumber, or otherwise transfer its rights or duties under this contract without the prior written consent of the State. State may reasonably withhold consent for any reason.

This contract may terminate for cause in the event of its assignment, conveyance, encumbrance or other transfer by the Contractor without the prior written consent of the State.

24. **Third Party Beneficiaries:** This contract shall not be construed as providing an enforceable right to any third party.
25. **Captions:** The captions or headings in this contract are for reference only and do not define, describe, extend, or limit the scope or intent of this contract.
26. **Severability:** If any provision of this contract is determined by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid or unenforceable to any extent, the remainder of this contract shall not be affected and each provision of this contract shall be enforced to the fullest extent permitted by law.
27. **Governing Law:** This contract shall be governed by the laws of the State of Kansas and shall be deemed executed in Topeka, Shawnee

County, Kansas.

28. **Jurisdiction:** The parties shall bring any and all legal proceedings arising hereunder in the State of Kansas District Court of Shawnee County, unless otherwise specified and agreed upon by the State of Kansas. Contractor waives personal service of process, all defenses of lack of personal jurisdiction and forum non conveniens. The Eleventh Amendment of the United States Constitution is an inherent and incumbent protection with the State of Kansas and need not be reserved, but prudence requires the State to reiterate that nothing related to this Agreement shall be deemed a waiver of the Eleventh Amendment.
29. **Mandatory Provisions:** The provisions found in Contractual Provisions Attachment (DA 146a) are incorporated by reference and made a part of this contract.
30. **Integration:** This contract, in its final composite form, shall represent the entire agreement between the parties and shall supersede all prior negotiations, representations or agreements, either written or oral, between the parties relating to the subject matter hereof. This Agreement between the parties shall be independent of and have no effect on any other contracts of either party.
31. **Debarment of State Contractors:** Any Contractor who defaults on delivery or does not perform in a satisfactory manner as defined in this Agreement may be barred for up to a period of three (3) years, pursuant to K.S.A. 75-37,103, or have its work evaluated for pre-qualification purposes. Contractor shall disclose any conviction or judgment for a criminal or civil offense of any employee, individual or entity which controls a company or organization or will perform work under this Agreement that indicates a lack of business integrity or business honesty. This includes (1) conviction of a criminal offense as an incident to obtaining or attempting to obtain a public or private contract or subcontract or in the performance of such contract or subcontract; (2) conviction under state or federal statutes of embezzlement, theft, forgery, bribery, falsification or destruction of records, receiving stolen property; (3) conviction under state or federal antitrust statutes; and (4) any other offense to be so serious and compelling as to affect responsibility as a state contractor. For the purpose of this section, an individual or entity shall be presumed to have control of a company or organization if the individual or entity directly or indirectly, or acting in concert with one or more individuals or entities, owns or controls 25 percent or more of its equity, or otherwise controls its management or policies. Failure to disclose an offense may result in the termination of the contract.
32. **Immigration and Reform Control Act of 1986 (IRCA):** All contractors are expected to comply with the Immigration and Reform Control Act of 1986 (IRCA), as may be amended from time to time. This Act, with certain limitations, requires the verification of the employment status of all individuals who were hired on or after November 6, 1986, by the contractor as well as any subcontractor or sub-contractors. The usual method of verification is through the Employment Verification (I-9) Form.

The contractor hereby certifies without exception that such contractor has complied with all federal and state laws relating to immigration and reform. Any misrepresentation in this regard or any employment of persons not authorized to work in the United States constitutes a material breach and, at the State's option, may subject the contract to termination for cause and any applicable damages.

Unless provided otherwise herein, all contractors are expected to be able to produce for the State any documentation or other such evidence to verify Contractor's IRCA compliance with any provision, duty, certification or like item under the contract.

33. **Worker Misclassification:** The contractor and all lower tiered subcontractors under the contractor shall properly classify workers as employees rather than independent contractors and treat them accordingly for purposes of workers' compensation insurance coverage, unemployment taxes, social security taxes, and income tax withholding. Failure to do so may result in contract termination.
34. **Injunctions:** Should Kansas be prevented or enjoined from proceeding with the acquisition before or after contract execution by reason of any litigation or other reason beyond the control of the State, Contractor shall not be entitled to make or assert claim for damage by reason of said delay.
35. **Statutes:** Each and every provision of law and clause required by law to be inserted in the contract shall be deemed to be inserted herein and the contract shall be read and enforced as though it were included herein. If through mistake or otherwise any such provision is not inserted, or is not correctly inserted, then on the application of either party the contract shall be amended to make such insertion or correction.
36. **Federal, State and Local Taxes:** Unless otherwise specified, the proposal price shall include all applicable federal, state and local taxes. The Contractor shall pay all taxes lawfully imposed on it with respect to any product or service delivered in accordance with this Contract. The State of Kansas is exempt from state sales or use taxes and federal excise taxes for direct purchases. These taxes shall not be included in the bidder's price quotation. Upon request, the State shall provide to the Contractor a certificate of tax exemption.

The State makes no representation as to the exemption from liability of any tax imposed by any governmental entity on the Contractor.

37. **Accounts Receivable Set-Off Program:** If, during the course of this contract the Contractor is found to owe a debt to the State of Kansas, agency payments to the Contractor may be intercepted / setoff by the State of Kansas. Notice of the setoff action will be provided to the Contractor. Pursuant to K.S.A. 75-6201 et seq, Contractor shall have the opportunity to challenge the validity of the debt. If the debt is undisputed, the Contractor shall credit the account of the agency making the payment in an amount equal to the funds intercepted.

K.S.A. 75-6201 et seq. allows the Director of Accounts & Reports to setoff funds the State of Kansas owes Contractors against debts owed by the Contractors to the State of Kansas. Payments setoff in this manner constitute lawful payment for services or goods received. The Contractor benefits fully from the payment because its obligation to the State is reduced by the amount subject to setoff.

38. **Definitions:** A glossary of common procurement terms is available at <http://da.ks.gov/purch>, under "Purchasing Forms".

SPECIAL PROVISIONS

Quarterly Reports: The contractor is required to submit a quarterly report to the Division of Purchases detailing all acquisitions made by the State from this contract. This report should include as a minimum the agency name, quantity, description and amount group number (even if the amount is zero).

Administrative Fee: Vendor(s) must pay a 1/2% Administrative Fee on all purchases (including political subdivisions) made against this contract. The fee is to be included in the cost (bid price) of the goods or services. The Administrative Fee is to be based upon the total dollars invoiced under the contract. The Administrative Fee shall be made in check form, payable to the "State of Kansas - Division of Purchases" and must be paid within 30 days following the end of each quarter.

Open-Ended Contract: This is an open-ended contract between a vendor and the State to furnish an undetermined quantity of a good or service in a given period of time.

Deliveries: All orders shall be shipped FOB destination, prepaid and included, within 90 (Ninety) days of receipt of a purchase order unless special options are specified. Deliveries must be clearly marked with the purchase order number. If delays in delivery are anticipated, the Contractor shall notify the ordering agency of the expected delivery date or partial delivery date. The order may be cancelled if delivery time is unsatisfactory. The Contractor shall inform the Division of Purchases of any supply or delivery problems.

Invoices: Each purchase order must be individually invoiced. Invoices shall be forwarded to the using agency in duplicate and shall state the following:

- (1) date of invoice;
- (2) date of shipment (or completion of work);
- (3) purchase order number and contract number;
- (4) itemization of all applicable charges; and
- (5) net amount due.

Contract Period: Date of Award through August 31, 2013 or until orders are no longer accepted by the Manufacturer..

Vehicle Purchase Request Form: All orders sent to Contractors must include a numbered vehicle purchase request form for each vehicle ordered. The Board of Regents Institutions (Universities) and Political Sub-divisions are exempt from this requirement. Contractor shall not accept orders which fail to include this form. A copy of the form is enclosed.

Orders: Orders will be placed periodically throughout the contract period by State Agencies. Agency orders will show options required, colors, title information delivery hours and the name of a contact person and telephone number. The State realizes that the manufacturer may discontinue accepting order prior to the contract termination date. Contractors shall inform the Division of Purchases of early order cutoff dates.

Payment Terms: Payment Terms are Net 30 days. Payment date and receipt of order date shall be based upon K.S.A. 75-6403(b). This Statute requires state agencies to pay the full amount due for goods or services on or before the 30th calendar day after the date the agency receives such goods or services or the bill for the goods and services, whichever is later, unless other provisions for payment are agreed to in writing by the vendor and the state agency. NOTE: If the 30th calendar day noted above falls on a Saturday, Sunday, or legal holiday, the following workday will become the required payment date.

The statute further defines the date goods or services are received as the date such goods or services are completely delivered and finally accepted by the state agency. The date the payment is made by the state agency is defined as the date on which the warrant or check for such payment is dated, i.e. warrant issue date.

Delivery: Vehicles delivered shall have mileage readings not to exceed 50 miles plus the mileage distance from the contractor's shipping point to the delivery location and in no case shall the odometer reading exceed 500 miles. The contractor shall notify the agency 48 hours prior to delivering the vehicle and shall comply with the Agency's delivery hours.

Contractor shall guarantee delivery of vehicles ordered prior to March 1, each model year. After March 1, Agencies shall contact vendor prior to placing orders to insure availability. If the Contractor receives an order and cannot guarantee delivery, the Contractor will immediately notify the ordering Agency in writing with a copy to the Procurement Officer.

Delivery Costs one firm price per mile is shown for delivery of each category of vehicle no matter the distance from the shipping point (defined as location of Pre-delivery Inspection) to the delivery point. Alternative pricing for delivery of multiple vehicles may also be shown. All shipping points in the Kansas City, Missouri Metro Area shall use Kansas City as the basis for figuring mileage. The attached mileage chart will be used to determine delivery charges if delivery is made to a city not shown based upon the contractor's unit price per mile. No "Delivery Charge" will be assessed if the vehicles are drop shipped to the delivery location and the State Agency performs the predelivery inspection.

Contractors will not charge mileage for delivery to destinations within the City where the shipping point is located. Delivery of vehicles to destinations located outside the boundaries of the specified City which result in a total delivery distance which exceeds the distance to any destination within the City boundaries will be allowed to assess the appropriate per mile charge for the difference in the two distances.

The Contractor agrees, if his proposal is accepted, to guarantee the design, material and workmanship of the unit bid according to the standard factory warranty, or for one year, whichever is greater. A copy of the warranty shall accompany the bid. Warranty coverage shall include costs of transporting the unit to and from factory authorized service center, when outside a 150 mile radius of the delivery point.

Miscellaneous Requirements (All Vehicles)

LICENSE TAG BRACKETS AND BOLTS: Each vehicle will be equipped with adequate license tag brackets to protect license tag. Sufficient bolts and fasteners shall be furnished to properly apply license tags on back of vehicle.

KEYS: Two complete sets of keys are to be furnished on substantial key rings. Operability of all keys must be verified by dealer prior to delivery.

KEY CODES: A printed record of key codes and corresponding manufacturer's identification numbers shall be furnished for each vehicle or vehicles listed on an invoice.

SERVICE: Each vehicle shall be serviced (prior to delivery) including all fluids to be at proper level. All doors, hatch cover (or trunk cover) and hood shall be properly adjusted. All fittings and attachments shall be accounted for. All mechanical adjustments (throttle linkage, headlights, front end) shall have been made. There shall be at least 1/4 tank of gas shown on the gas gauge at the time of delivery. Engine shall be protected with ethylene glycol antifreeze to 20 degrees below zero. Windshield Washers shall be full of winter strength solution to prevent freezing. Vehicle to be clean both interior and exterior.

Each vehicle delivered shall have a separate vehicle packet containing: 2 sets of operable keys; (**NOTE:** Contractor is to verify all keys are operable prior to delivery, payment may be delayed if any keys provided are inoperable) certificate of origin specifying the specific state agency as new owner; odometer statement; operator's manual; warranty standards; tire warranty. This packet must accompany each vehicle as it is delivered.

Floor Mats, when specified, shall be located in all passenger locations, may be dealer installed and shall be color coordinated with interior color.

Vehicles to be available in a sufficient variety of colors. Vendors will be required to provide a color card to each agency upon request.

Full size spare tires, when required, to be same brand, size and tread design as other tires. "Temporary USE" spare tires will not be acceptable as full size spare tires. If shipped loose, bidders are to so note as an exception.

Vehicles to comply with all Federal and State safety regulations.

Running Boards if specified on Vans are to be adjusted so they provide a practical stepping surface. Running Boards delivered which are adjusted so far under the Van that they are not functional will be rejected.

Contractors will provide any options not specified at Invoice cost or less as shown in the price schedule. Agencies will request these options from the State Procurement Officer. The Procurement Officer will then obtain pricing from the Contractor based upon written verification and inform the Agency of the cost.

Attached are specifications for the base vehicles.

The State of Kansas reserves the right to purchase vehicles from other than the Contractor if, as the result of a legal settlement, the State of Kansas becomes entitled to benefits which will allow for the purchase of vehicles at prices lower than quoted on this contract.

Contractors shall report to the manufacturer that the State Agency and Address shown on the purchase order is the proper address to use when mailing service recalls, warranty information or any other related correspondence. **Do not show the Division of Purchases as the owner of the vehicle.**

Delayed Warranty Start Date: When state agencies purchase a quantity of vehicles that are placed into storage, a delayed warranty start date shall be available, that reflects the actual date when that vehicle is first placed into service. This date shall not exceed 12 months from the invoice date.

E-85 Engine: An E-85 compatible engine shall be capable of operating on E-85 (85% ethanol and 15% unleaded gasoline, unleaded gasoline or any mixture of the two in the same tank.

When hybrid powered vehicles are specified, for the purpose of this contract, a hybrid powered vehicle shall be defined as having both a gasoline engine and rechargeable electric batteries to power electric motors. These vehicles are commonly referred to as a hybrid-Electric vehicle (HEV). The ninety (90) day delivery requirement is also waived and delivery will be subject to availability.

Quarterly Reports: The Contractor shall be required to file a quarterly report by each state agency or political subdivision making purchases under this contract. Reports are due no later than 30 days after the end of each calendar quarter **and shall correlate with figures submitted as Administrative Fees (see below).** Above referenced reports are to be filed with the Division of Purchases Open Records Officer or his/her designee located at 900 SW Jackson, Room 102N, Topeka, KS 66612-1286. Reports may also be required to be submitted to the specific using agency.

Electronic files shall be e-mailed to the following e-mail address: reports@da.ks.gov, in Microsoft® Excel or Microsoft® Access Database format.

The required reporting format may be found on the Division of Purchases website at <http://da.ks.gov/purch>, under the "Forms" link.

Report Types - Reports shall be available reflecting the following information. Agencies and the Division of Purchases reserve the right to request additional information.

- Sales Summary -- Report shall include a list of agencies and political subdivisions who have used the contract, a subtotal of sales to each agency or political subdivision, as well as a grand total of all sales.
- Items Sold -- Report shall include a list of items sold to agencies and political subdivisions, indicating the contract price and using agency, a subtotal of sales to each agency or political subdivision, as well as a grand total of all sales.
- Items Sold, by Agency - Same as above, except sorted by agency.

CONTRACTUAL PROVISIONS ATTACHMENT

Important: This form contains mandatory contract provisions and must be attached to or incorporated in all copies of any contractual agreement. If it is attached to the vendor/contractor's standard contract form, then that form must be altered to contain the following provision:

"The Provisions found in Contractual Provisions Attachment (Form DA-146a, Rev. 06-12), which is attached hereto, are hereby incorporated in this contract and made a part thereof."

The parties agree that the following provisions are hereby incorporated into the contract to which it is attached and made a part thereof, said contract being the _____ day of _____, 20_____.

- Terms Herein Controlling Provisions:** It is expressly agreed that the terms of each and every provision in this attachment shall prevail and control over the terms of any other conflicting provision in any other document relating to and a part of the contract in which this attachment is incorporated. Any terms that conflict or could be interpreted to conflict with this attachment are nullified.
- Kansas Law and Venue:** This contract shall be subject to, governed by, and construed according to the laws of the State of Kansas, and jurisdiction and venue of any suit in connection with this contract shall reside only in courts located in the State of Kansas.
- Termination Due To Lack Of Funding Appropriation:** If, in the judgment of the Director of Accounts and Reports, Department of Administration, sufficient funds are not appropriated to continue the function performed in this agreement and for the payment of the charges-hereunder, State may terminate this agreement at the end of its current fiscal year. State agrees to give written notice of termination to contractor at least 30 days prior to the end of its current fiscal year, and shall give such notice for a greater period prior to the end of such fiscal year as may be provided in this contract, except that such notice shall not be required prior to 90 days before the end of such fiscal year. Contractor shall have the right, at the end of such fiscal year, to take possession of any equipment provided State under the contract. State will pay to the contractor all regular contractual payments incurred through the end of such fiscal year, plus contractual charges incidental to the return of any such equipment. Upon termination of the agreement by State, title to any such equipment shall revert to contractor at the end of the State's current fiscal year. The termination of the contract pursuant to this paragraph shall not cause any penalty to be charged to the agency or the contractor.
- Disclaimer Of Liability:** No provision of this contract will be given effect that attempts to require the State of Kansas or its agencies to defend, hold harmless, or indemnify any contractor or third party for any acts or omissions. The liability of the State of Kansas is defined under the Kansas Tort Claims Act (K.S.A. 75-6101 et seq.).
- Anti-Discrimination Clause:** The contractor agrees: (a) to comply with the Kansas Act Against Discrimination (K.S.A. 44-1001 et seq.) and the Kansas Age Discrimination in Employment Act (K.S.A. 44-1111 et seq.) and the applicable provisions of the Americans With Disabilities Act (42 U.S.C. 12101 et seq.) (ADA) and to not discriminate against any person because of race, religion, color, sex, disability, national origin or ancestry, or age in the admission or access to, or treatment or employment in, its programs or activities; (b) to include in all solicitations or advertisements for employees, the phrase "equal opportunity employer"; (c) to comply with the reporting requirements set out at K.S.A. 44-1031 and K.S.A. 44-1116; (d) to include those provisions in every subcontract or purchase order so that they are binding upon such subcontractor or vendor; (e) that a failure to comply with the reporting requirements of (c) above or if the contractor is found guilty of any violation of such acts by the Kansas Human Rights Commission, such violation shall constitute a breach of contract and the contract may be cancelled, terminated or suspended, in whole or in part, by the contracting state agency or the Kansas Department of Administration; (f) if it is determined that the contractor has violated applicable provisions of ADA, such violation shall constitute a breach of contract and the contract may be cancelled, terminated or suspended, in whole or in part, by the contracting state agency or the Kansas Department of Administration.

Contractor agrees to comply with all applicable state and federal anti-discrimination laws.

The provisions of this paragraph number 5 (with the exception of those provisions relating to the ADA) are not applicable to a contractor who employs fewer than four employees during the term of such contract or whose contracts with the contracting State agency cumulatively total \$5,000 or less during the fiscal year of such agency.

- Acceptance Of Contract:** This contract shall not be considered accepted, approved or otherwise effective until the statutorily required approvals and certifications have been given.
- Arbitration, Damages, Warranties:** Notwithstanding any language to the contrary, no interpretation of this contract shall find that the State or its agencies have agreed to binding arbitration, or the payment of damages or penalties. Further, the State of Kansas and its agencies do not agree to pay attorney fees, costs, or late payment charges beyond those available under the Kansas Prompt Payment Act (K.S.A. 75-6403), and no provision will be given effect that attempts to exclude, modify, disclaim or otherwise attempt to limit any damages available to the State of Kansas or its agencies at law, including but not limited to the implied warranties of merchantability and fitness for a particular purpose.
- Representative's Authority To Contract:** By signing this contract, the representative of the contractor thereby represents that such person is duly authorized by the contractor to execute this contract on behalf of the contractor and that the contractor agrees to be bound by the provisions thereof.
- Responsibility For Taxes:** The State of Kansas and its agencies shall not be responsible for, nor indemnify a contractor for, any federal, state or local taxes which may be imposed or levied upon the subject matter of this contract.
- Insurance:** The State of Kansas and its agencies shall not be required to purchase any insurance against loss or damage to property or any other subject matter relating to this contract, nor shall this contract require them to establish a "self-insurance" fund to protect against any such loss or damage. Subject to the provisions of the Kansas Tort Claims Act (K.S.A. 75-6101 et seq.), the contractor shall bear the risk of any loss or damage to any property in which the contractor holds title.
- Information:** No provision of this contract shall be construed as limiting the Legislative Division of Post Audit from having access to information pursuant to K.S.A. 46-1101 et seq.
- The Eleventh Amendment:** "The Eleventh Amendment is an inherent and incumbent protection with the State of Kansas and need not be reserved, but prudence requires the State to reiterate that nothing related to this contract shall be deemed a waiver of the Eleventh Amendment."
- Campaign Contributions / Lobbying:** Funds provided through a grant award or contract shall not be given or received in exchange for the making of a campaign contribution. No part of the funds provided through this contract shall be used to influence or attempt to influence an officer or employee of any State of Kansas agency or a member of the Legislature regarding any pending legislation or the awarding, extension, continuation, renewal, amendment or modification of any government contract, grant, loan, or cooperative agreement.
