

2011 “Research and the State” Graduate Student Poster Session

Guidelines and Requirements for Abstract Submission and Participation

1. You must give a poster presentation at the "Research and the State" graduate student poster session.
2. Only one application form may be submitted per student.
3. Applicants may NOT present research that has been presented in the K-State Research Forum (KRF) or the Capitol Graduate Research Summit (CGRS) in a previous year.
4. At least partial results are preferred, but not required, for abstract submission. However, at the time of presentation, research should be at or near completion, and at least some results must be presented.
5. Prior consent of major advisor and/or faculty funding the research and all co-authors are required before submitting the abstract.
6. By participating in the "Research and the State" poster session, you may be selected as one of 10 K-State graduate students to give your poster presentation at the CGRS in Topeka on February 17, 2011.
7. If you wish to give an oral presentation or if you wish to give a poster presentation ONLY at K-State and do NOT wish to be considered for participation in the CGRS, please complete the KRF graduate student application form (www.ksu.edu/grad/research).
8. Only fully completed applications will be reviewed. You will NOT be able to save a partially completed application. If more than one application is submitted under your name, only your most recently submitted abstract will be reviewed.
9. All abstracts will be evaluated on grammar, clarity, ease of understanding the main concepts, and impact of research.
10. Only the student submitting the application and abstract may serve as the poster presenter at the "Research and the State" poster session and, if selected as one of the 10 K-State representatives, at the CGRS on February 17, 2011.
11. Deadline for abstract submission: 11:59 pm on November 19, 2010
