 - Will contact all of the houses to schedule inspections
 - Go through the checklist beforehand
 - 30 days is allowed until next inspection to make corrections
 - a plan of action
 - check to make sure fire alarms are on and have the green light showing
 - make sure fire extinguishers are in place and are charged
 - make sure exit doors are not blocked
 - fire drill has to be conducted within the first 10 days of school
 - make sure you call the fire department at 785.587.4504 to let them know about the fire drill
 - record information: evacuation time, people involved with the fire drill, etc.
 - make sure houses have secure doors
 - report any suspicious activities
 - there are no open flames allowed in the houses—they are allowed during rituals and meetings
 - get the extension cords out; do not overload any circuits
 - if hosting a party, make sure someone who is responsible does a sweep of the house to check for potentially dangerous things
