- Updates to the by laws concerning Greek Ambassadors, Director of Recruitment positions, and Public Relations.
- Amend Recruitment Rules & Code of Ethics
 - Section B.
 - The Recruitment Team and Chapter Executive Council may move into their chapter facilities no earlier than 12:00PM on the Monday preceding the first open house event... Chapter members may not move in earlier than 12:00PM on the Tuesday preceding the first open house event.
 - Section G. Recruitment Guides. Part b.
 - The number of recruitment guides will be at the discretion of the Panhellenic Directors of Recruitment and the Panhellenic Advisors.
 - Section I. Eligibility and Expectations. Part c.
 - Entering freshman must have a minimum 2.7 cumulative high school GPA, and upperclassmen must have a minimum 2.4 cumulative college GPA
