

## Resolution to establish a PHC Extension Committee

Whereas, The recruitment efforts of Kansas State University's 11 NPC organizations continue to be successful and community totals and averages are record breaking; and

Whereas, It is believed a number of female students are unable to affiliate with the existing NPC chapters; and

Whereas, A resolution presented to Kansas State University Panhellenic Council in Fall 2007 by the Community Growth Planning Workgroup passed and set predictors for extension; and

Whereas, A discussion of interested and present chapter advisors, alumnae volunteers, and the Primary Sorority Advisor resulted in a desire to explore Extension options and further research Extension;

Let it be resolved, That the Kansas State University Panhellenic Council form and appoint an Extension Committee made up of representatives from all 11 member organizations with 6 committee seats reserved for undergraduate members, all of which are offered voting privileges in committee decisions, as well as the Primary Sorority Advisor and a Panhellenic Council Board of Directors representative, both of whom are not offered voting privileges in committee decisions; and

Let it further be resolved, That the Kansas State University Panhellenic Extension Committee consult with the National Panhellenic Council and follow procedures for exploring and considering extension as outlined in the National Panhellenic Council's Manual of Information; and

Let it further be resolved, That the Kansas State University Panhellenic Extension Committee be given the power to confirm extension is appropriate or in fact state extension is not appropriate at this time; allowing the committee to only continue should they justly feel Extension is a viable option for growing AND sustaining the Kansas State University sorority community.
