

# Fraternity Experience Participant Expectations and Guidelines

*The Interfraternity Council has adopted the following regulations so that recruitment may be as fair as possible to all persons concerned. All men participating in recruitment are responsible for observing these guidelines and should become familiar with them. If serious infringements of Interfraternity Council guidelines occur, penalties may be imposed including, but not limited to dismissal from the recruitment experience.*

I, \_\_\_\_\_ (Participant's Name) desire to participate in the 2010 Fraternity Experience. I agree to follow all safety rules established for the 2010 Fraternity Experience and further agree to refrain from conduct that creates risk for me and other participants.

1. In being a participant in the Fraternity Experience, I agree to follow all state, federal, local and IFC laws and policies, including but not limited to NO ALCOHOL consumption by all participants and attendees. Use of alcohol or illegal substances will result in dismissal from the Fraternity Experience. No refunds will be given.
2. Potential new members may not visit sorority houses during the Fraternity Experience.
3. Potential new members will be assigned to groups at the time of registration and must attend all events with the group to which they have been assigned. Potential new members may not deviate from their assigned individual schedule.
4. Potential members are expected to attend all recruitment functions. Potential new members are not allowed to leave the Fraternity Experience activities without their Recruitment Guide and Fraternity Advisor's permission.
5. In the case of illness or personal/family emergency at any time during the fraternity experience, a potential new member should notify his recruitment guide and necessary arrangements will be made.
6. If any potential new member wishes to withdraw from the Fraternity Experience he must contact his recruitment guide. Final withdrawal procedure is channeled through the K-State Interfraternity Council Advisor.
7. I understand that I do not have to participate in any games or activities that I do not feel are safe or healthy activities. Additionally, I understand that by participating in activities I accept responsibility for any injuries or damages caused by my participation.
