## Honor & Integrity System History

Did you know that the Honor & Integrity System at KSU was started by a group of STUDENTS?

In 1994, a major incident of cheating occurred in Biology that included over 100 students and made national television and print news. Out of those involved, 75 students received F's in the class and faced potential criminal charges because there was not a system in place at that time.

Former Provost, Dr. James Coffman, was approached by six students demanding a better system. He formed a task force made up of faculty, administrators, and students to make suggestions on exactly what would work for everyone involved.

In 1999, the KSU Honor System was launched. The name was later changed to the KSU Honor & Integrity System, but the message and procedures have remained true to the original vision of those six students who wanted to make a difference at their university.

Carrying on that initiative, HIPE members help educate everyone at K-State and K-State at Salina about academic integrity and serves as advisors for those who find themselves in the system.

## WHAT HIPE MEMBERS DO...

As the interactive component of the H&I System at KSU, it is our main job to educate students, faculty, and administration about the H&I System. We hold professional development seminars for new faculty and Graduate students, take part in new student orientations, and most importantly, we talk to other students about how the system works and how to get involved!

We also mentor those students who find themselves in violation of the University Honor Pledge. HIPE'rs are assigned to each Alleged Violator of and are at their sides through every step to answer questions and help them feel more at ease. We inform and advise students about Honor and Integrity System policies and procedures so that they are prepared and focused on all aspects of their case.
