Treaty Article #22

1. I was a resident of India on the date of my arrival in the United States. I am not a U.S. citizen. I have not been lawfully accorded the privilege of residing permanently in the United States as an immigrant.
2. I am visiting the United States for the purpose of teaching or conducting research at Kansas State University. I will receive compensation for my teaching or study activities.
3. The teaching or research compensation received during the entire tax year (or during the period from _____ to _____) for these activities qualifies for exemption from withholding of federal tax under the tax treaty between the United States and India.
4. Any research I perform will be undertaken in the public interest and not primarily for the private benefit of a specific person or persons.
