

Statement of Purpose

KSU Juggling Club

Name and Purpose

This organization shall be known as the KSU Juggling Club.

The purpose of this organization will be to bring together people interested in learning to juggle and those people interested in improving juggling skills.

Membership will be open to all interested parties. As a student organization 80% of the members must be students of Kansas State University.

To become a member a person must attend at least two meetings; demonstrate an interest in learning to juggle or improving their juggling skills. A new member must submit their contact information to the Secretary. They will be inducted as a new member and added to the roll at the first meeting after they have submitted their contact information.

A member must attend at least 50% of all regular meetings in a semester. If a member fails to attend at least 50% of the meetings in a semester their name will be removed from the roll for the following semester. If a member joins too late in the semester, then they must attend 50% of the meeting held after they are inducted in order to remain a member for the following semester.

Officers

The officers of this organization shall be President, Vice-President, Event Coordinator, Treasurer, Secretary, and Webmaster.

Officers will be elected at the end of the spring semester by the process of nomination followed by a plurality vote. Officers will serve a term of one year.

Duties of the President include scheduling meeting times and places, presiding over meetings, incurring leadership responsibilities as necessary tasks arise.

Duties of the Vice-President include replacing the President in the event of his or her absence, maintaining club equipment, if present.

Duties of the Event Coordinator include correspondence with community members to arrange gigs and the planning of club hosted events.

Duties of the Treasurer include keeping track of KSU Juggling Club finances, and presenting a report at each regular meeting.

Duties of the Secretary include maintaining a current and up to date list of members, taking roll at each regular and special meetings.

Duties of the Webmaster include updating and maintaining the club website.

Dues

There will be no annual dues or membership fees. However, members may pool funds for specific purposes. Examples of this include any club equipment purchased for use by members, or an out of town trip to a juggling convention.

Meetings

Regular meetings will be held on every Thursday of every month that classes are in session. The President determines the time and place of regular meetings.

The President, for emergencies or special events may schedule extra meetings. Every effort should be made to inform all members of special meetings either at regular meetings or through other means of communications.

A quorum shall be 50% of registered members. At each meeting roll will be taken, business will be discussed and juggling will take place.
