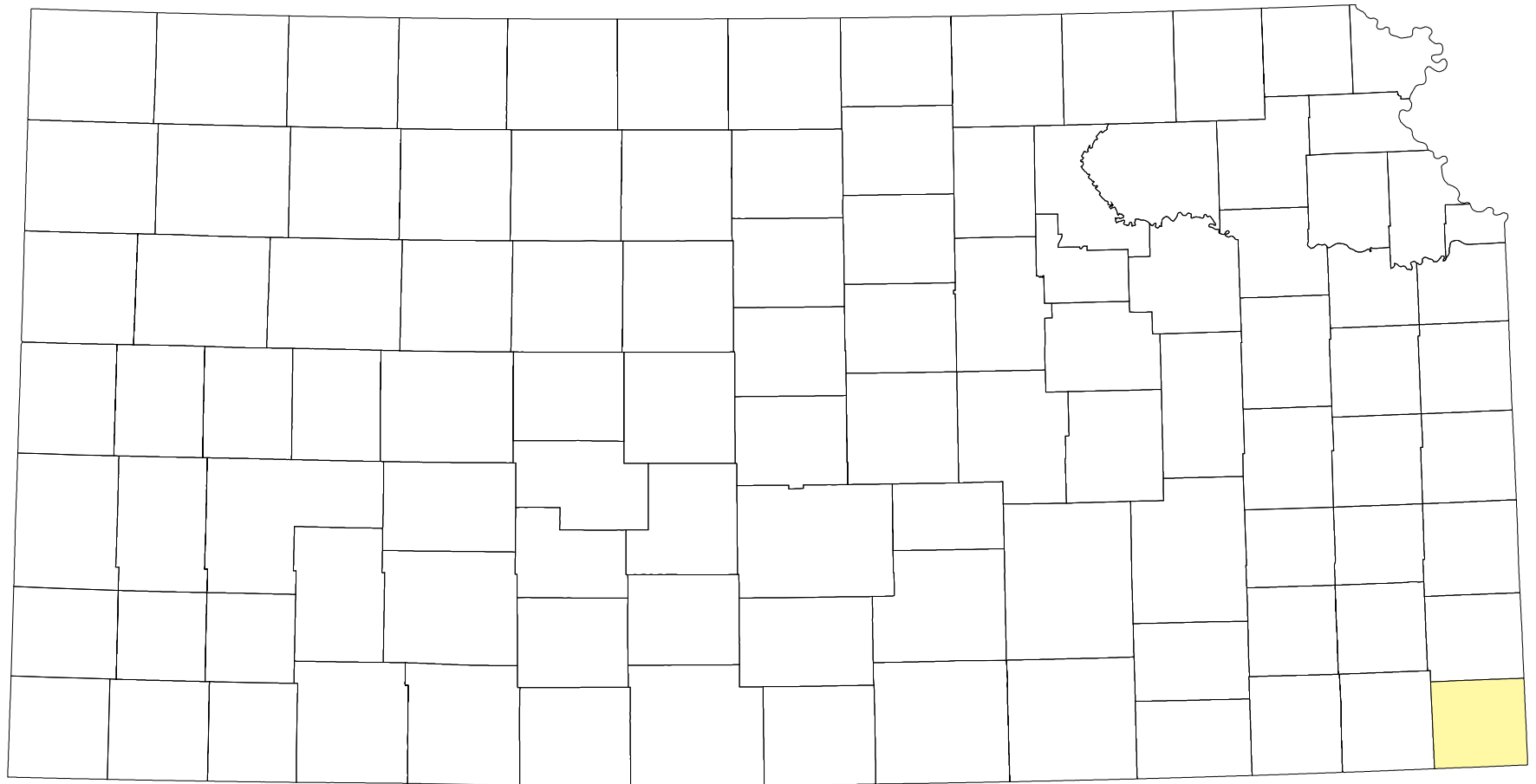
Restricted to cave habitat in Cherokee, Co., KS
