Anderson and Robbins, 1981 smallest forest detected = 4,000 ha.

### **Habitat Restrictions**

Ogden and Stutchbury, 1994 inhabits forests > about 15 ha.  
[KS GAP] no minimum habitat size in Kansas indicated.

### **Comments**

Hooded Warblers occur in upland and lowland situations but only in the most mature mesic forests.

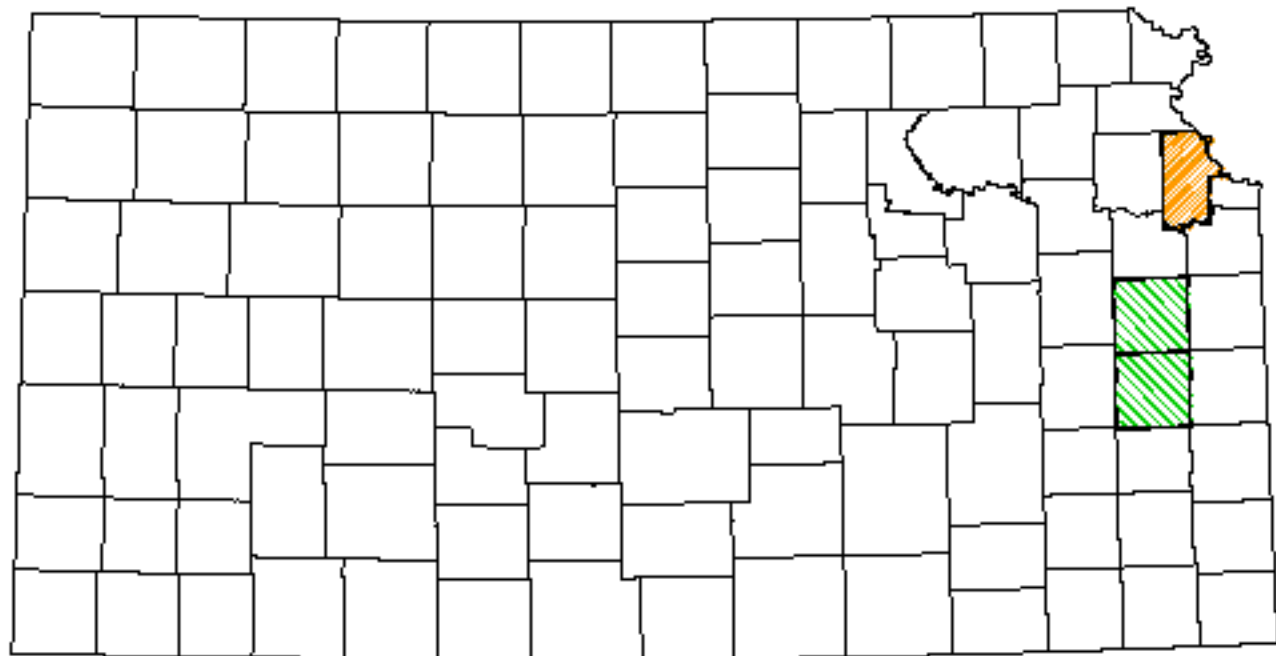
