The KS AFS Chapter is offering the Otto Tiemeier-Frank Cross Student Scholarship to a deserving graduate student and the Klaassen Award to a deserving undergraduate student. Each will be a \$300 scholarship, and the Chapter will pay expenses for the recipients to attend our annual meeting.

Applications for these awards should be submitted to the scholarship committee chair by December 19, 2009. A one-page statement of achievements, aspirations, and goals should be written by the student. The student should also solicit a one-page letter of reference from a major professor, or instructor who is familiar with the student. This letter should detail the student's qualifications, and should also be submitted by December 19, 2009 (either accompanying the student's application, or under separate cover). Both the student's application and the reference should include the student's full name, address, telephone number, and college affiliation. Award recipients will be notified prior to the Kansas Chapter meeting held February 4-5, 2010 during the Kansas Natural Resources Conference.
