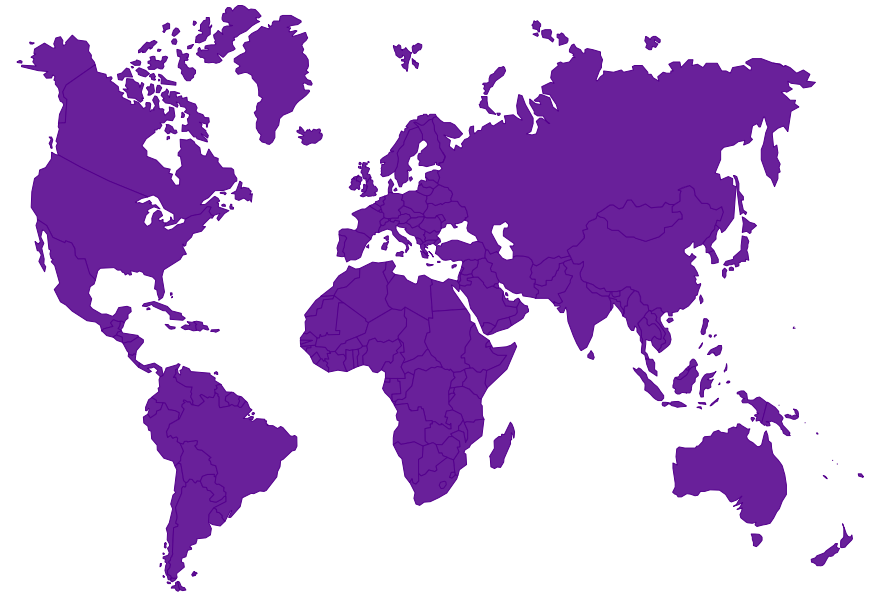

Lafene Health Center Travel Clinic



Lafene Health Center offers a travel clinic to assist students, faculty or staff who are traveling stateside or beyond the borders of the United States. This service is offered through the Allergy and Immunization Clinic.

Travel Clinic Hours:

Monday through Friday (by appointment)
8:00 AM to 11:30 AM
1:00 PM to 4:30 PM

Call (785) 532-6544 to schedule an appointment, for current prices, or additional information.

What to expect at your travel consult:

- Review of vaccination requirements for the region being visited.
- Travel recommendations for the region based on current health and safety precautions.
- Worksheet completion listing requirements and recommendations.
- Referral to a physician for any medications, health assessment, or needed instruction. **(Referrals require an additional appointment with Health Center staff.)**
- Vaccinations are available and may be initiated at the time of the initial consult.

United States Department of State recommendations on political issues, road and travel conditions, and potential terrorism problems are included in the travel consult.

Appointment Checklist

(What to do and know ahead of time.)

- Schedule your appointment well in advance of your trip. Some vaccination requirements may take several months to be completed.
- An initial travel consult requires a thirty-minute appointment.
- Allow sixty minutes if both a travel consult appointment and vaccinations are scheduled.
- Complete the Travel Clinic Form: www.k-state.edu/lafene/travelinfo.pdf
- Bring a record of your prior immunizations to ensure all immunizations are current.**

Cost:

- There is no charge for travel clinic visits.
- **Charges** assessed include, but are not limited to:
 - Medication(s) purchased through the Lafene Pharmacy.
 - Vaccinations given at the Health Center.
 - Physical examinations done by the Health Center Staff. **(Physical exams are scheduled as a separate appointment.)**

Remember to bring your completed Travel Clinic Form and your immunization record.
