In addition to the formal letter of offer you have received, below are the other benefits and elements of the position of Vice President for Communications and Marketing that we have discussed:

Moving expenses: All moving expenses from Lee's Summit, MO, to Manhattan, KS, will be paid for by the University.

Tickets: Since attendance at university athletic and cultural events are considered a job expectation, you will be provided two tickets to football, men's basketball, and women's basketball games. Football tickets will be in the President's Suite and basketball tickets will be in the President's reserved seats. We will provide additional tickets for football and basketball games for your guests, but they may not be in the same location.

Club memberships: You will be provided with a Manhattan Country Club membership.
