The GRE requirement has been "turned off" in CollegeNET. The vote was 60% to 40% in favor of removing the requirement. We can turn it back on at any point. The "Statement of Objectives" will be updated when the Graduate School does the annual update with CollegeNET in the summer.

Distinguished Thesis and Distinguished Dissertation Awards

The Graduate School is accepting nominations for the <u>MAGS/ProQuest Distinguished Thesis</u> <u>Award</u> and <u>CGS/ProQuest Distinguished Dissertation Award</u>, which serve to recognize theses and dissertations that have made unique contributions to the student's field of study. For both awards, each graduate program may nominate one student in each category: 1) Arts and Humanities, 2) Biological/Life Sciences. Nominees must have been awarded their degree between July 1, 2019 and Jun 30, 2021. **Nomination deadline is May 7**.
