It is **strongly suggested** that students **follow the prescribed plan**. Classes may be moved up in the sequence, but should not be pushed back. Specifically, Percussion Tech, String Tech I, and String Tech II must be taken in the appropriate semester (or earlier). Failing to do so may result in a student having to attend extra semesters to complete required coursework.
