- ___ “C” or higher in Expository Writing I (ENGL 100, or 110)
- ___ “C” or higher in Expository Writing II (ENGL 200, or 125)
- ___ “C” or higher in Public Speaking I (COMM 106)
- ___ “C” or higher in College Algebra (MATH 100)
- ___ “C” or higher in Elements of Statistics (STAT 325)
- ___ Complete Teaching as a Career (EDSEC 200)
- ___ Complete Early Field Experience (EDSEC 230)
- ___ Complete Introduction to Teacher Education (DED 075)
- ___ Pass PPST with scores of 172 for Writing, 173 for Reading, and 172 for Math

A half recital or an extended “jury” recital is required before graduation. Divisional recommendation determines the methods of satisfying this requirement.

Instrumental majors are required to participate in marching band for at least two semesters (preferably during the freshman and sophomore years). String majors may substitute a comparable experience for this requirement.

Piano proficiency requirements **must** be met one semester before scheduling student teaching. (*Students will not be allowed to complete the STAR form without a passing score for piano proficiencies*)
