As Vice President/Vice Provost for Research at Kansas State University from 1998 to 2014, served as the chief research officer with oversight responsibility for research administration and compliance; led Kansas State's efforts from 2006 to 2014 to bring the \$1.25 billion NBAF R&D laboratory to Kansas.

As Dean of the Graduate School at Kansas State from 1998 to 2007, managed policy development, administrative services, and program oversight for all master's and doctoral degree programs.

As President of the Kansas State University Research Foundation from 1995 to 2011, facilitated the patenting and commercialization of intellectual property derived from university research.

As a Professor at Ohio State University from 1978 to 1994, directed research on cancer diagnostics and carcinogenesis in the Comprehensive Cancer Center and taught biochemistry in the medical school.

- ❑ Administered the Comprehensive Cancer Center's tissue/tumor procurement service, assessed by the National Cancer Institute as the most cost-effective service in the U.S. at the time.
- ❑ Directed the Ohio State Biochemistry Program, the largest interdisciplinary graduate program at the university with over 80 faculty scientists from 6 colleges and 16 departments.
