Scholarship application due dates are rapidly approaching; apply while there is time!

Scholarships available through Adult Student Services

Stop by Adult Student Services at 101 Holton Hall for applications for the following scholarships, or go to www.ksu.edu/adult/scholarships.

The Adult Student Scholarship: \$1,500 - \$2,000. This scholarship is for older female students returning to school because of loss of job, husband, etc. who find they must support themselves and/or their family. Financial need will be considered in the selection process.
Deadline: Feb. 1.

Adult Student Services EOF Scholarship for Full-Time Students: Nine \$700 awards. Full-time non-traditional students enrolled at K-State.
Deadline: Feb. 1.

Adult Student Services EOF Scholarship for Part-Time Students: Two \$350 awards. Part-time non-traditional students enrolled at K-State.
Deadline: Feb. 1.

The League of Women Voters Stella Harris Scholarship: One \$500 award. Full-time non-traditional undergraduate student. Minimum GPA is 2.4 for at least 30 semester hours.
Deadline: March 15.

Ruth Ann Wefald Scholarship: One \$500 award. Full-time undergraduate students at K-State. Minimum GPA is 3.0.
Deadline: Apr. 12.

The Dr. Michaeline Chance-Reay KSU Social Club Scholarship: One \$250 award. Part-time graduate non-traditional female student. Demonstrate academic commitment and community service.
Deadline Apr. 12.

K-State First Ladies Scholarship: One \$500 award. Part-time non-traditional student enrolled at K-State.
Deadline: Apr. 12.

Edna S. Young KSU Social Club Scholarship: One \$500 award. Full-time non-traditional students enrolled at K-State.
Deadline: Apr. 12.

The Allison McQuilliam Memorial Scholarship: One \$500 award. Full-time undergraduate non-traditional student. Preference to married non-traditional student with a child under the age of 5 years.
Deadline: July 15
