The Flint Hills Veterans Coalition established this scholarship in recognition of the academic dedication and leadership of Kansas State University student veterans. The scholarship will be awarded to a student who demonstrates academic commitment, leadership, and financial need. There will be three recipients of the Student Veteran Scholarship per academic year, with one (1) \$1000 scholarship awarded in the fall semester, one (1) \$1000 scholarship awarded in the spring semester, and one (1) \$500 scholarship awarded in the summer semester. The award will be payable to the student in one payment, during the semester for which the scholarship was awarded.

The following criteria will be used to select the scholarship recipient:

- 1. The recipient must be a military veteran, honorably discharged from service. (Students who are currently serving in the National Guard or Reserves are also eligible to apply for this scholarship.)
- 2. The recipient must be a full-time <u>undergraduate</u> student enrolled in a degree-seeking program at Kansas State University during the 2013-2014 academic year.
- **3.** Must be a first-time recipient of this scholarship. Previous Student Veteran Scholarship recipients are not eligible.

HOW TO APPLY

- 1. Fill out the application form on the reverse side.
- 2. Provide documentation of financial need in ONE of the following formats:
 - a) Apply for Student Financial Aid (complete a 2013-2014 FAFSA).
 - b) A copy of your 2012 Federal Income Tax Form(s).
 - c) Any additional records, such as copies of Veteran's benefits.
- 3. Submit a one-page, typed summary describing:
 - a) Your academic and career goals, and your plans toward achieving them,
 - b) Information regarding your financial need,
 - c) Any unique circumstances/obstacles you may be facing,
 - d) Information regarding your prior service (i.e. branch and dates of service, tours served, awards received, etc.)
- 4. Submit application packet on time! Late or incomplete applications will not be considered.
- 5. The scholarship recipient may be asked to speak at a 2013-2014 Flint Hills Veterans Coalition event.
