

## Scholarship for Non-Traditional Students

### SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS

- ❖ Up to three (3) incentive grants of \$1,000 each for the 2011-2012 academic year.

The Manhattan Branch of the American Association of University Women (AAUW) is pleased to make these scholarship awards available to female, non-traditional students as defined below. We are aware of the challenges facing women today and encourage you to take advantage of this opportunity.

### QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS

- Female students attending Kansas State University during the 2011-2012 academic year. Students taking courses solely through distance education **do not** qualify.
- Must be returning to school after at least a three (3) year lapse in education. Applicants may have already entered or returned to college after this time lapse.
- Must have at least two complete semesters of credit remaining before graduation.
- Must be a Bachelor degree candidate enrolled for a minimum of twelve (12) credit hours per semester **or** graduate degree candidate enrolled for a minimum of nine (9) credit hours per semester or six (6) credit hours per semester with a graduate assistantship.

**ALL REQUIREMENTS MUST BE FULFILLED FOR YOUR APPLICATION TO BE CONSIDERED.**

### DIRECTIONS FOR COMPLETING SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

1. Fill in all blanks carefully. Use additional pages if space provided is not adequate.
2. The application should be submitted in printed form. Handwritten applications will not be accepted.
3. Include with completed application form:
  - a. A transcript of credit from each institution where you have received college credit. (See Section II. (A), Pg. 1)  
NOTE: Some schools will only send transcripts to the Scholarship Chair and you should send name with your request.
  - b. Biographical sheet (See Section III. (A), Pg. 1)
  - c. Three references. (See Section V., Pg. 2)

### IMPORTANT DATES

<b>April 1, 2011 (Fri)</b>	<b>Postmark deadline for submitting material (application, transcripts, and reference letters).</b>
April 25, 2011 (Mon)	Last day for finalists to be notified for an interview date and time.
May 1, 2011 (Sun)	Interviews for finalists to be conducted in the afternoon.
May 9, 2011 (Mon)	Last day for finalists to receive notification of scholarship award.

**Scholarship recipients may be asked to speak at a 2011-2012 Manhattan Branch meeting.**
