**An Endowed Fund of the Greater Manhattan Community Foundation**



The Manhattan Branch of the American Association of University Women was organized in 1920 as the fifth Kansas Branch of the Association of Collegiate Alumnae shortly before the national association changed its name to the American Association of University Women. When the Manhattan Branch was formed, it made a financial commitment to develop scholarship funds for women at Kansas State University. By the early 1920's they had raised enough money to start awarding scholarships and loans to KSU female students in their Junior or Senior year. Eventually, a Graduate Student Scholarship was also developed. Over the years, the funds have grown and the criteria have changed, making the scholarships what they are today. In 2012, members of the Manhattan AAUW Branch established the American Association of University Women Manhattan Branch KSU Scholarship Fund at the Greater Manhattan Community Foundation ("GMCF"). Through this endowed fund, Manhattan AAUW Branch members have ensured permanent scholarship support for female, non-traditional students working toward a degree from Kansas State University. GMCF is pleased to make up to three (3) incentive grants of \$1,000 each for the 2013-2014 academic year available to female, non-traditional students as defined below.

**QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS**

- Female students attending Kansas State University during the 2013-2014 academic year. Students taking courses **solely** through distance education **do not** qualify.
- Must be returning to school after at least a three (3) year lapse in education. Applicants may have already entered or returned to college after this time lapse.
- Must have at least two complete semesters of credit remaining before graduation.
- Must be a Bachelor Degree candidate enrolled for a minimum of twelve (12) credit hours per semester or graduate degree candidate enrolled for a minimum of nine (9) credit hours per semester or six (6) credit hours per semester with a graduate assistantship.

**ALL REQUIREMENTS MUST BE FULFILLED FOR YOUR APPLICATION TO BE CONSIDERED.**

<b>April 1, 2013 (Monday)</b>	<b>Postmark deadline for submitting material (application, transcripts, &amp; reference letters).</b> Applications will be reviewed by the AAUW Manhattan Branch KSU Scholarship Fund Selection Committee.
April 24, 2013 (Wed)	Last day for finalists to be notified for an interview date and time.
May 5, 2013 (Sun)	Interviews for finalists to be conducted in the afternoon.
May 13, 2013 (Mon)	Estimated date for finalists to receive notification of scholarship award.
