**Awards Banquet Committee**

- Changes in OTY's
  - First Year Experience award
    - Wants to remove the requirement that the recipient live in the halls the following year
    - Renee thinks we should remove it because it's about what they did not what they might do
    - Sarah made the point that the award could be a springboard for a person to get more involved and should encourage them to stay
    - Russ brought up that we can't determine why they are leaving and they shouldn't be
  - Outstanding Service Award
    - Cleaned up the wording on the requirements to the bid
    - Thinking about eliminating the 100 word blurb because there is also a 500 word essay that could take its place
      - The blurb is what's in the program book and could get really long if you allowed everyone 500 words
      - Renee suggested changing it to 250 words and combining the essay and the blurb
      - Renee moved to get rid of the 500 words essay completely and change the blurb from 100 words to 500 words and include in the blurb why the person should win and their accomplishments
        - 2<sup>nd</sup>, voted, and passed

- Advisor of the year
  - Removed third requirement about additional involvement in floor or housing community outside of the advisers required duties
  - Ty clarified why it's in the requirements
  - Megan suggested moving the third requirement to a recommended criteria
    - Reword the requirement to clarify wording
    - Informal vote held and it will be moved to recommended
- Program of the Year
  - Last year a program lasted the whole year and there was confusion on whether it still fit the requirements
  - The ABC committee removed the requirement that the program be five total days or less
  - Ty suggested we focus more on the impact on the program than the time limit
  - Tony brought up that by focusing on the impact we might be giving certain more socially conscience programs have a bigger chance to win
  - Kevin brought up in the past that socially programs that were one night have won over longer socially conscience programs
  - Andy moved to leave the five day limit in the requirement to keep them more equal
    - 2<sup>nd</sup>
    - Discussion continued
  - Dave suggested to alter the criteria of the OTY so that it's easier to make determine the winner
  - Kevin: In the future we might be looking at adding more program of the year awards (Active, Passive, Short term, Long term), and posed the question "Are we recognizing who we want to with this award?" and is that a question we want to answer tonight or deal with later?
  - Chris: Suggested to amend Andy's motion to seven days
  - Andy withdrew his motion
  - Voted and decided to remove the time limit from the requirement
- Sarah explained what OTY's are and what the blurb is
- OTY kickoff party next Thursday in the DARK
- Committee meeting after the big meeting
- Diamond power cat award
  - Recognized a leader on in each hall who has been overlooked by the recognition process
  - We might eliminate it because we are now recognizes each hall already
  - Tony: This recognizes people who are not a traditional leader in the hall
  - Jardine gets this award as well
    - But only get one as a whole instead of each neighborhood
    - Should we start giving one to each of the three neighborhoods
    - Tony: This might be something to do in the future but we might want to wait until
  - Renee moved to keep diamond power cat award
    - 2<sup>nd</sup>, voted and passed
