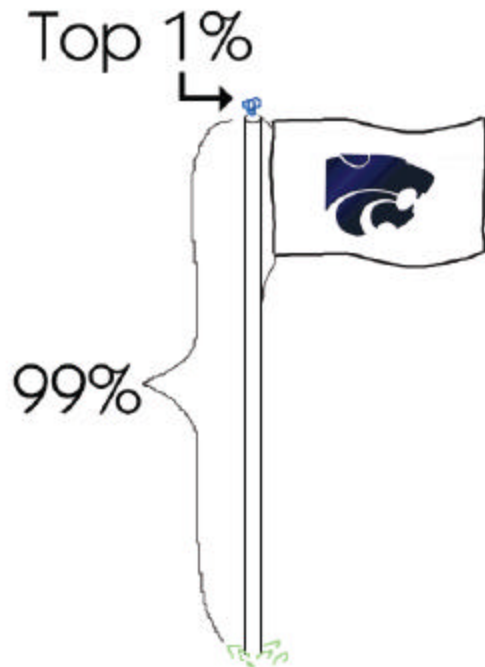
All members who have not picked up their shirts are encouraged to do so.
