

## Selected National Scholarships for Study Abroad

<b>Blue Key</b> D Mar / April A Fr – Sr	Blue Key awards a significant number of \$500 scholarships at the campus level each year. Study abroad funding is one option that students can compete for. Blue Key prefers candidates who exhibit a strong record of leadership. There is an interview process.
<b>Bridging to Japan</b> D Variable A Fr – Sr	Bridging Scholarships for Study in Japan fund \$2500 or \$4000 for semester or year programs in Japan respectively. 100 awards are made annually. All majors may apply. <b>British Council</b> D Varies A Fr – Gr	Website compiles number of awards beyond the Rhodes and Marshall that will fund international visitors to the United Kingdom: at the graduate or undergraduate level. <a href="http://www.britishcouncil.org/usa">www.britishcouncil.org/usa</a> .
<b>Boren</b> D Jan / Feb A Fr – Gr	Funds study abroad to most nations (excluding Western Europe, Canada, Australia and New Zealand). Provides up to \$10,000 per semester. Eligibility: US citizen. Interested in working in areas related to national security. Study proposal relates to the goals of the NSEP. There is also a Boren award for graduate study abroad. <b>Critical Language</b> D See website A Fr - Gr	Critical Language Scholarships fund program cost for intensive summer language study in languages deemed critical to national interests. Eligibility: US citizens enrolled or graduated within the last two years. Over 500 awards. Beginning through advanced level study. <a href="https://clscholarship.org/home.php">https://clscholarship.org/home.php</a> .
<b>DAAD</b> D Variable A So – Gr	Funds various programs for study in Germany, ranging from three weeks of intensive language study to a year of postbaccalaureate research. Some awards will support German internships as well. Eligibility: Typically US or Canadian citizenship. Required language skills vary with the award. <b>ETA Awards</b> D Variable A Sr / Gr	Not really a scholarship. However, it is worth noting that paid positions as English Teaching Assistants are available in multiple countries. <b>Fulbright</b> D October A Sr / Gr	Funds academic year abroad. Provides for most expenses. Can study in most countries. Program is designed by the applicant. Eligibility: US citizen. Language proficiency for host country. Complete BA/BS before grant begins. <a href="http://us.fulbrightonline.org/home.html">http://us.fulbrightonline.org/home.html</a> .
<b>Gates Cambridge</b> D October A Sr / Gr	Expenses and stipend for graduate degree at Cambridge. Eligibility: Accepted to Cambridge University. Under the age of 30. Any nationality outside the UK. 3.5 or higher GPA. Evidence of high potential in chosen field. <a href="http://www.gatesscholar.org">www.gatesscholar.org</a> .
<b>Gilman</b> D Oct / April A Fr – Sr	Study abroad to almost any country. For undergraduates. Any major. Up to \$5000 towards semester or year programs. Eligibility: US citizen/US national. Must get a Pell Grant to qualify. Consult with Office of International Programs regarding the Gilman and your plans for studying abroad. <a href="http://www.iie.org/gilman">www.iie.org/gilman</a> .
<b>Golden Key</b> D Oct / April A Jr / Sr	10 awards of \$2000 each for study abroad. Application deadline depends upon when you plan to study abroad. Eligibility: membership in Golden Key and undergraduate status. Active participation in Golden Key is probably valued. <a href="http://www.goldenkey.org">www.goldenkey.org</a>
<b>Killam</b> D Jan A So / Jr	Killam Fellowships award \$5000 or \$10,000 to fund junior semester or year at any university in Canada. Must speak French to attend Francophone schools. Eligibility: US citizens in any field. Superior academic achievement. Award is new in 2007. <a href="http://www.killamfellowships.com">www.killamfellowships.com</a> .
<b>Marshall</b> K March/April D October A Jr / Sr	Funds study at any university in the UK for two years. Eligibility: US citizen. Award tenable within two years of BA/BS graduation. Minimum 3.7 GPA. Looking for scholarship and leadership. Demonstrated potential in field. Graduate goals consistent with preparation. Good rationale for study in the UK. <b>Mitchell</b> K March/April D October A Jr / Sr	Funds graduate study in Ireland or Northern Ireland for one year. Eligibility: US citizen. Intellectual distinction and active involvement. Demonstrated potential to lead and serve others. - NSCS** National Society of Collegiate Scholars awards one \$5000 award each semester for study abroad. Also one \$2500 award for summer abroad. Two awards for Semester at Sea are also offered. Eligibility: NSCS member with full-time undergraduate standing. [www.nscs.org](http://www.nscs.org).

**A** Check w/ NSCS
- Pearson** Provides \$1000-\$10,000 for study abroad. Eligibility: Kansas resident for 5 years. Accepted to or attending Kansas graduate program related (broadly) to foreign affairs. Strong academic record. Need is considered. Jim Hohenbary will have applications.

**A** Sr / Gr
- Phi Kappa Phi** Study Abroad Grants in the form of 50 \$1000 scholarships. Eligibility: Any major. Must have between 30 and 90 credit hours and a 3.5 or higher GPA. [www.phikappaphi.org](http://www.phikappaphi.org). PKP membership is not required. Good for summer study abroad, but anytime in the upcoming year is possible.

**A** Jr
- Rhodes** Funds one to two years of study at Oxford. Seeking students who will work for the good of the world in whatever field they choose. Eligibility: Under 25 when the award begins. Show potential in service and leadership. Intellectual distinction. GPA 3.75 or higher typically. US citizen or citizen from other eligible country. Good rationale for study at Oxford. - K** March/April  
**D** October  
**A** Jr – Gr
- Rotary** Funds study abroad for one year to further individual international understanding. Eligibility: Any major. Applicant cannot be related to an active Rotarian. Language skills for host country. Leadership and communication skills are valued. Steven Graham and Rebecca Gould coordinate the Rotary scholarships on campus. **A** So – Gr
- Sigma Delta Pi** Spanish language honor society offers multiple awards for summer or semester abroad in a variety of Spanish-speaking countries. Must be a Spanish major or minor and affiliated with Sigma Delta Pi. Funds tuition and possibly a travel stipend. [www.citadel.edu/mlng/sigmadeltpi/](http://www.citadel.edu/mlng/sigmadeltpi/).

**A** Jr – Gr
- World Peace** Rotary award funds two years of graduate study abroad related to peace and conflict issues. Sites in Japan, Australia, Argentina, US and England. Eligibility: No relation to Rotarians. Language skills for host country and proficiency in a second language. Consult with Scholarship Office regarding deadlines.
