All fraternal and campus related organizations will follow this policy in the selection of their members, except the prohibition against sex discrimination shall not apply to social fraternities or sororities which are excluded from the application of Title IX of the Educational Amendments of 1972.

Regents Policy on Student Organizations and Activities: The established policy of the Board of Regents of the State of Kansas prohibits discrimination on the basis of age, race, color, religion, sex, marital status, national origin, physical handicap or disability, status as a Vietnam Era Veteran, sexual orientation or other factors which cannot be lawfully considered, within the institutions under its jurisdiction. All fraternal and campus-related organizations shall follow this policy in the selection of their members, except the prohibition against sex discrimination shall not apply to social fraternities or sororities which are excluded from the application of Title IX of the Education Amendments of 1972.

The right of organizations to establish standards for membership is acknowledged, provided that all students are afforded equal opportunity to meet those standards. Just as all students have the right to choose those with whom they would associate on the campus, an organization shall have the right to select its members subject to these principles. Nothing in this policy shall be interpreted as imposing a requirement which would violate the principle of selection on the basis of individual merit.

The responsibility for compliance with this policy lies with each organization. In discharge of this responsibility, each organization shall acknowledge its understanding of this policy. Such acknowledgement shall assure that there exist no restrictions on membership, either local or national, which violate this policy.

Registration Compliance Statement:

To register or maintain registration, the organization must agree to the following regulations:

1. Abide by the established policies of the University, Board of Regents, and the State of Kansas prohibiting discrimination in membership.
2. Abide by all University policies, campus regulations, federal, state, and local laws.
3. Maintain at least five members.
4. Membership must consist of at least 50% students for University Community status.
5. Maintain an advisor who is a full-time member of the KSU faculty, staff, or administration.
6. Maintain a current copy of the organization's constitution on file in the OSAS.
7. Maintain a current listing of officers on file in the OSAS.

Requirements for organizations seeking recognition from the OSAS or to maintain registration are not limited to those listed above. Noncompliance with any of these requirements is adequate grounds for revocation of registration.
