PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION SURVEY**

4 **BY:** Governmental Relations Committee

6 **WHEREAS,** Kansas State University students would benefit from having a public transportation  
7 system;

8  
9 **WHEREAS,** The city of Manhattan created the Transit Implementation Plan in 2001;

10  
11 **WHEREAS,** The Riley County Area Transportation Agency (aTa Bus) is planning to implement the  
12 Transit Implementation Plan.

13  
14 **WHEREAS,** aTa Bus in cooperation with the City of Manhattan and the Kansas Department of  
15 Transportation is currently in the process of revisiting and updating the Transit  
16 Implementation Plan;

17  
18 **WHEREAS,** aTa Bus has requested Kansas State students' input in the revision of the city's current  
19 plan;

20  
21 **WHEREAS,** The survey will allow Kansas State students to voice their opinions and concerns about  
22 public transportation in the city; and

24 **WHEREAS,** The successful implementation of the Transit Implementation Plan will depend largely on  
25 Kansas State University's participation in the stakeholder discussions.

THE USD 383 BOND ELECTION**

7 **WHEREAS,** Manhattan-Ogden USD 383 facilities are becoming increasingly out-of-date, with an average  
8 square foot of space in the district being 49 years old;  
9

10 **WHEREAS,** USD 383 has been experiencing growth that is outpacing district facilities capacities;  
11

12 **WHEREAS,** The students of Kansas State University have recognized that facilities maintenance is a major  
13 factor in creating a positive learning environment for students through their support of deferred  
14 maintenance funding for the University;  
15

16 **WHEREAS,** The quality of Manhattan schools directly affects Kansas State students through recruitment and  
17 retention of qualified faculty as well the maintenance of a thriving local community; and  
18

19 **WHEREAS,** A \$97.5 million bond issue has been proposed that will directly affect 24 buildings in the district  
20 by increasing classroom space, updating facilities for healthy buildings and increasing school  
21 safety controls among other improvements. This USD 383 School Bond Election will be voted on  
22 in the General Election on Tuesday, November 4, 2008.

27 Election in the General Election on Tuesday, November 4, 2008.
