7 Teachers of Agriculture Crops Contest April 18 at Tarleton State University in
8 Stephenville, Texas;

10 **WHEREAS,** Fifteen teams from two- and four-year colleges and universities participated in the
11 competition;

13 **WHEREAS,** The team also placed second in identification and third in the lab practical phases of the
14 contest;

15
16 **WHEREAS,** The competition tested participants' skills in four areas. The agronomic quiz evaluated
17 knowledge of crop production and management, crop physiology and breeding, soils and
18 tillage, soil fertility, crop harvesting and storage, weeds, insects, and diseases. During the
19 laboratory practical, competitors identified insects, diseases, weeds, fertilizers, stored
20 grains, forage and processed crop products, and field and laboratory equipment. In
21 addition, the contest also included crop and weed plant and seed identification, and
22 agronomic calculations and equipment calibration; and

24 **WHEREAS,** Team members Alex Bolack, Jason Rugan, Matt Wyckoff, Matt Pacht, Josh Andres, and
25 Josh Patterson, along with their coach Gerry Posler, should be commended for the hard
26 work they invested in bringing this honor to K-State.
