7 **WHEREAS,** Kansas State University strives to compete at the highest level in all of its athletic
8 programs;

10 **WHEREAS,** Athletes play an integral role in representing Kansas State University on a
11 national level;

13 **WHEREAS,** Student support can play a large role in the overall success of athletic programs at
14 Kansas State University;

16 **WHEREAS,** ICAT has lost its original initiative of being a student led spirit group;

17
18 **WHEREAS,** The Kansas State University Student Governing Association, in consultation with
19 the Athletic Department, should research possibilities for students to get involved
20 with athletics;

22 **WHEREAS,** The Kansas State University Student Governing Association and the Athletic
23 Department should also look at re-vamping the current ICAT program or starting
24 a new spirit organization;

26 **WHEREAS,** Appointments to this committee should be subject to Student Senate approval.

28 **BE IT ENACTED THAT:**

30 **SECTION 1.** There is hereby established the Special Committee for Student Support of
31 Athletics with the following purpose:

33 1. Increase support and attendance of all Kansas State University athletic events.
34 2. Look into the possibility of renovating the current ICAT program or starting a
35 new spirit program.
36 3. Form a proposal to present to Student Senate.

38 **SECTION 2.** The Special Committee for Student Support of Athletics shall submit its final
39 proposal to the Student Body President and the Student Senate Chair by the end of
40 the 2008-2009 Student Senate term. The committee shall also present its proposal
41 to Student Senate.

43 **SECTION 3.** A copy of this bill shall be sent to Athletic Director Bob Krause, Deputy Athletic
44 Director Jim Epps, Associate Athletics Director for Student Services Phil Hughes,
45 Associate Athletics Director Laura Tietjen, Assistant Director of Marketing Joni
46 Smoller, Vice President of Student Life Pat Bosco, and Kansas State University
47 President Jon Wefald.
