5. Gary Leitnaker discussed the progress of the parking garage and provided a copy of the site plan. Gary presented the following issues to Melissa Hildebrand to discuss with the Transportation committee: 1) Handicap parking accessibility; 2) Traffic flow; 3) Management of reserved parking on Mid-Campus Drive during the construction; 4) Shuttle parking during the schools session.
6. The meeting was officially called to order at 4:14 pm.
7. November minutes were discussed. Motion was made to accept minutes. Motion was seconded and passed.
8. Loleta Sump reported for the Finance Committee. Permit fees were discussed. A second meeting will be scheduled.

9. Bicycle Committee report from Tim Schrag included the criticism that the bike stalls need to be cleared off during snowstorms. In addition, he would like to see “no skating” signs be posted throughout campus. He discussed the damage to areas on campus from the skateboarders. A motion was made for the Chair to send a letter to Ronnie Grice, Director of Police, requesting enforcement of the Traffic and Parking regulation IV: F. which prohibits skateboarding on campus. The motion was seconded and passed.
10. Melissa Hildebrand stated the Transportation Committee would meet on February 1, at 3:30pm. Also, Melissa asked for a volunteer participate in the SGA Student forum on January 31, to answer Parking Garage questions. Ann Marie Treinen, Chair, agreed to participate.
11. The council discussed a petition from 34 faculty members to the president asking for reconsideration in building the parking garage. Dr. Thomas Rawson, Vice President for Administration and Finance, responded with the letter stating the parking garage will be built.
12. The subject of West Stadium construction during that same time period the parking garage is being built was discussed. Definite plans for the construction were not confirmed, but the need to use part of the West Stadium parking lot (D1) for equipment will be addressed if needed.
13. Motion to adjourn was seconded and passed at 4:41 pm.
