- one or more \$6,000 Distinguished Member Undergraduate Scholarships; and
- one or more \$1,000 undergraduate awards.

All applications are considered for the Thomas Arkle Clark Scholar-Leader of the Year Award.

## **INSTRUCTIONS**

**Undergraduate Applicants:** Submit your completed application to your chapter adviser by the local scholarship deadline. If your chapter nominates you, your adviser must complete the adviser certification below and submit your application to the National Office by the national deadline.

**Graduate Applicants:** You may submit your completed application to your chapter adviser or directly to Phi Eta Sigma's National Office by the national deadline listed below. Contact the national office at 270-745-6540 or phi.eta.sigma@wku.edu for instructions on submitting the application directly.

**Advisers:** For each *undergraduate* scholarship application, please complete the adviser certification at the end of this form and submit the application to the National Office by the national deadline. Login to the Adviser Resources at phietasigma.org to upload applications.

For *undergraduate* scholarships, chapters may nominate at least 2 applicants. Chapters that inducted 300 or more new members during the previous academic year may nominate one additional applicant for each 300 additional inductees (300-599 inductees = 3 applicants, 600-899 inductees = 4 applicants, 900-1199 inductees = 5 applicants, 1200-1499 inductees = 6 applicants, etc.).

For graduate scholarships adviser certification is NOT required and there is no limit on the number of applicants.

**Recommendation Letters:** Applicants may submit up to three (3) letters of recommendation. The letters of recommendation are helpful, but they are not required. Please merge all letters of recommendation into one file for submission.
