

NASA Request for Information on Isolation Facility for Scientific Studies

A National Aeronautics and Space Administration (NASA) Request for Information (RFI), entitled, "Isolation Facility for Scientific Studies" (NNJ15ZBH008L), has been released. NASA desires to conduct scientific investigations in facilities that provide extended periods of isolation and confinement for a minimum of four subjects participating in the simulated space mission studies. The purpose of these investigations is to better understand the factors that are likely to be present in long duration exploration space missions, and may include studies involving behavioral health and performance, human factors, medical, physiological, and habitability concerns. Potential durations for such missions may range from 2 weeks to 12 months.
